 4. "...and yet you are coming to me?" Hail Mary...
 5. "Jesus said to him in reply, 'Allow it for now...'" Hail Mary...
 6. "...for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Hail Mary...
 7. "Then he allowed him." Hail Mary...
 8. "After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him..." Hail Mary...
 9. "...and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him." Hail Mary...
 10. "And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.'" Gloria

WEDDING FEAST AT CANA - Our Father.. Second Mystery
 (John 2:1-12)

1. "On the third day there was a wedding in Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there." Hail Mary...
2. "Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding." Hail Mary...
3. "When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, 'They have no wine.'" Hail Mary...
4. "And Jesus said to her, 'Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.'" Hail Mary...
5. "His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you.'" Hail Mary...
6. "Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings..." Hail Mary...
7. "Jesus told them, 'Fill the jars with water.' So they filled them to the brim." Hail Mary...
8. "Then he told them, 'Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter.'" Hail Mary...
9. "And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, (he said), '...Everyone serves the good wine first,...and then an inferior one;...'" Hail Mary...
10. "...but you have kept the good wine until now." Hail Mary... Gloria



INSTITUTION OF THE EUCHARIST – Our Father
 Fifth Mystery (Luke 22:14ff, John 6:51)

1. "When the hour came, he took his place at table with the apostles." Hail Mary...
2. "...I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer..." Hail Mary...
3. "...for I tell you, I shall not eat it again until there is fulfillment in the kingdom of God." Hail Mary...
4. "Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and said, 'Take this and share it among yourselves.'" Hail Mary...
5. "...For I tell you that from this time on I shall not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." Hail Mary...
6. "Then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them..." Hail Mary...
7. "This is my body, which will be given for you..." Hail Mary...
8. "...do this in memory of me." Hail Mary...
9. "And likewise the cup after they had eaten saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you.'" Hail Mary...
10. "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Hail Mary... Gloria

TRANSFIGURATION – Our Father... Fourth Mystery
 (Luke 9:29-36)

1. "(Jesus) took Peter, John and James and went up the mountain to pray." Hail Mary...
2. "While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothes became dazzling white." Hail Mary...
3. "And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory..." Hail Mary...
4. "...and (they) spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem." Hail Mary...
5. "Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him." Hail Mary...
6. "As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, 'Master, it is good that we are here;...' Hail Mary...
7. "Let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.' But he did not know what he was saying." Hail Mary...
8. "While he was speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud." Hail Mary...
9. "Then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my chosen Son; listen to him.'" Hail Mary...
10. "After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. They fell silent and did not at that time tell anyone what they had seen." Hail Mary... Gloria

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE KINGDOM

Third Mystery, 'Healing of the Paralytic' (Mark:2:1-12)
 Our Father...

1. "When Jesus returned to Capernaum after some days, it became known that he was home." Hail Mary...
2. "Many gathered together so that there was no longer room for them, not even around the door, and he preached the word to them." Hail Mary...
3. "They came bringing to him a paralytic carried by four men." Hail Mary...
4. "Unable to get near Jesus because of the crowd, they opened up the roof above him." Hail Mary...
5. "After they had broken through, they let down the mat on which the paralytic was lying." Hail Mary...
6. "When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Child, your sins are forgiven.'" Hail Mary...
7. "Now some of the scribes were sitting there asking themselves, 'Why does this man speak that way?... Who but God alone can forgive sins?'" Hail Mary...
8. "Jesus immediately knew in his mind what they were thinking to themselves..." Hail Mary...
9. "...and so he said, 'Why are you thinking such things in your hearts? Which is easier to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, pick up your mat and walk?'" Hail Mary...
10. "But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority to forgive sins on earth,' he said to the paralytic, 'I say to you, rise, pick up your mat and go home.' He rose, picked up his mat at once and went away in the sight of everyone." Hail Mary... Gloria
