 1. “Then going out he went, as was his custom to the Mount of Olives, and the disciples followed him.”  
 Hail Mary...  
 2. “When he arrived at the place he said to them, ‘Pray that you may not undergo the test.’” Hail Mary  
 3. “After withdrawing about a stone’s throw from them and kneeling, he prayed...” Hail Mary...  
 4. “Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me;...” Hail Mary...  
 5. “...still, not my will but yours be done.”  
 Hail Mary...  
 6. “and to strengthen him an angel from heaven appeared to him.” Hail Mary...  
 7. “He was in such agony and prayed so fervently that his sweat became like drops of blood falling to the ground.” Hail Mary...  
 8. “When he rose from prayer and returned to his disciples, he found them sleeping from grief.”

**SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR-Our Father..**  
**Second Mystery (John 18:28ff, John 19:1)**

5. “Jesus answered, ‘My kingdom does not belong to this world...’” Hail Mary...
6. “Pilate said to him, ‘Then you are a king?’”  
Hail Mary...
7. “Jesus answered, ‘You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth.’” Hail Mary...
8. “Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice.” Hail Mary...
9. “Pilate said to him, ‘What is truth?’” Hail Mary
10. “Then Pilate took Jesus and had him scourged.”  
Hail Mary... Gloria



**CROWNING OF THORNS-Our Father...**

**Third Mystery**(Matthew 27:27ff, John 19:4, John 19:14ff)

1. "Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus inside the praetorium and gathered the whole cohort around him." Hail Mary...
2. "They stripped off his clothes and threw a scarlet military cloak about him." Hail Mary...
3. "Weaving a crown out of thorns, they placed it on his head, and a reed in his right hand." Hail Mary...
4. "And kneeling before him, they mocked him, saying, 'Hail, King of the Jews!'" Hail Mary...
5. "Once more Pilate went out...to them... 'Look, I am bringing him out to you, so that you may know that I find no guilt in him.'" (John 19:4ff) Hail Mary...
6. "So Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple cloak. And (Pilate) said to them, 'Behold the man!'" Hail Mary...
7. "When the chief priests and guards saw him they cried out, 'Crucify him, crucify him!'" Hail Mary...
8. "It was preparation day for Passover, and it was about noon. And (Pilate) said to the Jews, 'Behold your king!'" (John 19:14ff) Hail Mary...
9. "Pilate said to them, 'Shall I crucify your king?'" Hail Mary...
10. "The chief priests answered, 'We have no king but Caesar.' Then they handed him over to be crucified." Hail Mary... Gloria

**CARRYING OF THE CROSS-Our Father...**

**Fourth Mystery** (Stations of the Cross, Luke 23:27-28)

1. Pilate washes his hands of Jesus. Hail Mary...
2. Jesus embraces his cross. Hail Mary...
3. Jesus falls the first time. Hail Mary...
4. Jesus meets his mother on the way. Hail Mary...
5. Jesus falls the second time. Hail Mary...
6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus. Hail Mary...
7. Jesus falls the third time. Hail Mary...
8. "As they led him away they took hold of a certain Simon, a Cyrenian, who was coming in from the country; and after laying the cross on him, they made him carry it behind Jesus." Hail Mary...
9. "A large crowd of people followed Jesus, including many women who mourned and lamented him." Hail Mary...
10. "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me, weep instead for yourselves and for your children..." Hail Mary... Gloria

**HAIL HOLY QUEEN**  
Hail Holy Queen, Mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. - THE CRUCIFIXION -Our Father... Fifth Mystery**  
(Luke 24:33ff, Psalm 22:18, John 19:26-30)
1. "When they came to the place of the Skull, they crucified (Jesus) and the criminals there, one on his right, the other on his left." Hail Mary...
  2. "Then Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, they know not what they do.'" Hail Mary...
  3. "They stare at me and gloat; they divide my garments among them; for my clothing they cast lots." Hail Mary...
  4. "...the rulers...sneered at him and said, 'He saved others, let him save himself if he is the Chosen One, the Messiah of God.'" (Luke 24:35ff) Hail Mary...
  5. "Now one of the criminals...reviled Jesus, saying, 'Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us.'" Hail Mary...
  6. "The other...rebuking him, said..., 'Have you no fear of God,..for the sentence we received corresponds to our crimes, but this man has done nothing criminal.'" Hail Mary...
  7. "Then he said, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.'" Hail Mary...
  8. "He replied to him, 'Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise.'" Hail Mary...
  9. "When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple there whom he loved, he said to his mother, 'Woman, behold your son.' Then he said to the disciple, 'Behold, your mother.'" (John 19:26-27) Hail Mary...
  10. "Jesus said, 'I thirst.' There was a vessel filled with common wine. So they put a sponge soaked in wine on a sprig of hyssop and put it to his mouth. When Jesus had taken the wine, he said, 'It is finished.' And bowing his head, he handed over his spirit." Hail Mary... Gloria
