F. New Evangelization

- -- Justine couldn't be present, so John Rakouskas read her notes.
- -- November initiative was saints helping us love the unlovable.

- -- December initiative will focus on the saints of Advent, those who show us the way.
- -- The commission thanks Louise Christ, Jeanne Brzycki, and Carolyn Groves for their continued support.

G. Spiritual Life

- -- Therese Rakouskas: the commission went through calendar to be on track for the year
- -- Kathy Wood is the commission co-chair.

H. Vocations

- -- Carla Dell'Olio: Seminarian gift card Christmas tree is up.
- -- Christmas cards went out to 16 seminarians; "let them know they are in our daily prayers"
- -- Card also let them know that there will be a Mass for their intentions on Sunday 26 April
- -- One of Vocations Crosses broke; Carla suggests getting a shorter crucifix with a wider base. Fr. Jack: go ahead and get one you determine is sensible.
- -- The Vocations Cross is no longer well booked—maybe another nudge from the altar?

5. Old Business

A. Chalice of Salvation Mass

-- Went well; Carla reported that the choir was magnificent.

6. New Business and Other Reports

A. Update on Ornament and CD sales

- -- Louise Christ sent an email detailing where things stood as of 6 December (PC council meeting's date), which will be entered into the record but to summarize:
 - -- \$3,433.00 in CD sales, so must get \$414.14 to break even. Approximately 225 sold; amount is not precise because some people pay with a \$20 and don't take their \$5 in change.
 - -- Approximately \$2,170–\$2,190 in ornament sales as of that date; approximately \$1,275–\$1,295 more to sell to break even. So far 109 ornaments sold.

B. Organ

- -- Deposit went in for the organ; it will be up and running for Easter 2017.
- -- The decorative pipes in the church can stay; will just need to take out three or four of the smaller ones.

C. Fr. Jack Personal Note

- -- Christmas letter went out with schedule of Christmas Masses.
- -- The parish's membership in formed.org will be in lieu of Christmas gift (i.e., no CD), as it costs \$1,000 per year.
- -- Bishop is visiting every parish to see how things are running, etc. He and his team spend a day and meet with everyone. They will be in Belchertown in April or May.
- -- Fr. Jack is postponing changes in the bylaws and elections of chair, co-chair of pastoral council until after that visit.
