

Guidelines for Resuming Mass at the Church of the Madalene

Things to know before coming to Mass:

- If you are sick or feel sick, we ask that you worship from home. 10am Mass will be streamed every Sunday on our Facebook page.
- Please adhere to the City of Tulsa guidelines for mask usage. Ushers and volunteers are required to wear masks per diocesan guidelines. (Those attending Mass are encouraged to bring their own masks.)
- Hand sanitizer is available for use in multiple locations throughout the church.
- Water fountains are currently closed.
- The nursery is currently closed.
- Pews are cleaned and sanitized regularly.

Things to know when arriving at Mass:

- Taking up a collection during Mass has temporarily been suspended. Collection baskets are located in the vestibule.
- Handouts for each Mass with the hymns and responsorial psalms are available in the vestibule.
- Ushers are scheduled for each weekend Mass to assist with the social distancing of families and individuals as you enter the Church, go to Communion, and leave.
- Holding hands during the Lord's Prayer is prohibited, as, regardless of these policies regarding COVID-19, it is not part of the Mass in the Roman rite.
- The sign of peace between parishioners will be omitted. After the priest offers Christ's peace to the people and the people respond, the Mass will continue with the Lamb of God.
- Bishops strongly recommend receiving Communion in the hand during this time. If you would like to receive on the tongue, please receive from the deacon.

Distribution of the Holy Eucharist for those not returning to Mass in person:

- Communion will be available for 30 minutes following the 10am Mass on Sundays for those who do not feel comfortable returning to Mass in person but who stream the Mass at home. Please park near the portico in the south parking lot and watch for the priest or deacon.
