Dear Alive in Christ Participant,

Thank you for the generosity and support you displayed during the *Alive in Christ* campaign. Your discipleship is an inspiration to our parish community!

Because of your support, we were able to improve our parish facilities by repairing and repainting the golden roof, and resurfacing the parish parking lot. In addition, we were able to supply funding to families in our Catholic Education and Faith Formation programs, as well as strengthen existing and new Faith Formation curriculums.

Recently, I have been in conversations with our Parish Finance Committee and at the current time, we have \$80,160 remaining from our *Alive in Christ* funds. We would like to use these funds on new parish and school projects that have become a need since the *Alive in Christ* campaign ended on March 31, 2018.

The first project we would like to have considered, is a new phone system with an integrated PA system. This will allow for better communication and enhance our security system.

Second, is repairs to address the drainage issues that have been plaguing our campus. This will allow for proper drainage to the property and prevent flooding to the church.

Third, based off the feedback from the parish, we are in great need of a new sound system in the Dome. With the update of the sound system we will be able to host plays, concerts, retreats, as well as give us the ability to rent out the facility to bring in additional revenue.

In order to meet the needs of our parish and improve our worship services, we will be utilizing the remaining funds from the *Alive in Christ* campaign to complete these needs.
