

# Christmas Angel Tree



We are again requesting your support for the Christmas Angel Tree Project sponsored by Catholic Health Mount St. Mary's Hospital. Each angel contains the sex and age of a child that is served by MSMH Neighborhood Health Center, Heart, Love and Soul Food Pantry, and community referrals that qualify for assistance.

Christmas trees with angels are located at both church sites— St. Peter and St. Bernard. Each angel specifies a requested gift, with the clothing size for that child. After choosing the angel, please return the gift (place under the Christmas tree at each church) in a box or gift bag, unwrapped, with the angel attached to the gift, no later than Sunday, December 9, 2018. Gifts may be returned to either church site. **It is absolutely important that the angel be attached to the gift.** If you do not want to choose an angel, warm hats, gloves, scarves and socks are always appreciated.

Parents will be able to come “shopping” for their children at the Niagara Falls Conference Center on Saturday, December 15, 2018 in time for the holidays. We will be looking for volunteers to help at the Conference Center on Friday, December 14 and Saturday, December 15, as well as to sort gifts at both church sites.
