SACRAMENT PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS

If you would like to apply for your child to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and/or Eucharist, please register your child for Religious Education classes. In order to be eligible for reception of these Sacraments...

- ❖ your child must be a baptized Catholic in grade 2 (or older)
- the Religious Education department must receive proof of the child's Catholic baptism



if baptized at Epiphany: fill out necessary information on application

if baptized elsewhere: obtain a copy of the Catholic Baptismal Certificate and include with the application for sacrament preparation classes. If you do not have the certificate, please contact the baptismal church and request a copy. If you have difficulty locating an address or phone number, please ask us for assistance

- the minimum formation requirements are the following: must be currently enrolled and attending Religious Education classes or attending Catholic school and ongoing participation in weekend Mass
- the program consists of Sunday afternoon classes which must be attended by at least one parent/guardian <u>AND</u> child. Weekly attendance at Religious Education classes continue to be required
