<i>POSITION</i>	<i>DESCRIPTION</i>
TEACHER (Elementary)	Prepares for class and teaches lesson every week; assisted by aide or co-teacher and supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff.
CO-TEACHER (Elementary)	Shares in preparation and teaching duties; BOTH teacher and co-teacher attend class each week; supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff.
AIDE (Elementary)	Assists teacher in classroom and attends each class; supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff.
CATECHIST TEAM (Middle School/High School)	Works in group to facilitate program sessions; training and support ongoing.
SUBSTITUTE (Elementary, Middle/High School)	Fills in for teacher or aide with little notice.
CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD Team Leader / Co Leader	<i>Training sessions and materials provided:</i> leads Liturgy of the Word for children.
Discussion Leader	leads small group discussion and activity.
OUTREACH IN LOVE	Works with youth or young adults with mental disabilities weekly from October – May at St. Edward Parish
