**Feast Day: February 2**

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is also known as the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and “Candlemas Day”, the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ as the light of the world.

Candles will be blessed at the 12 PM Mass.

It is also the World Day for Consecrated Life, which was instituted in 1997 by Pope St. John Paul II.

Before Mass begins, in place of our normal First Friday prayers, we will pray the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary at 11:30 AM.
