



"Viator House - Reflecting Catholic Teaching"

Fr Corey Brost, C.S.V., is executive director of Viator House of Hospitality, a home for young adult men seeking asylum in the nation who have nowhere to live while they adapt to life in the U.S. He is a member of the Clerics of St. Viator, a Catholic religious order of brothers, priests and lay associates. He joined the order in 1987 and has served as a religious educator, classroom teacher and high school administrator. He served as president of St. Viator High School in Arlington Heights from 2013-2016. He left with support from the Viatorians to work full time as an advocate for immigrant rights and interfaith bridge-building. He co-founded Viator House in 2017.

He co-founded the Children of Abraham Coalition in 2010 with Shaheen Khan to counter the increasing faith-based prejudice he saw in our nation and world. The Coalition, a 501(c) 3 non-profit located in Chicago's northwest suburbs, plans events for all ages that promote interfaith relationships, reverence and literacy. It is governed by a board of Muslim, Jewish and Christian leaders, one third of them high school and college age.






Our Emcee: Chuck Swirsky





Mother Cabrini - Zuote of the Week

From the book's introduction to this letter written aboard ship in 1900:

From LaHavre, Mother Cabrini stopped briefly in Paris and made a pilgrimage to Lourdes, where she was favored with a deep spiritual experience. She traveled to Madrid where the Infanta Eulalia of Bourbon had spoken to Queen Maria Christine about the Institute founded b Cabrini and its activity.

Favorable impressed, the Queen entrusted to Mother Cabrini the direction of a school for the orphans of the soldiers who were killed in the Cuban war. The Leo XIII School was begin in Madrid in 199 and in a short time became one of the best and most frequented schools in the Spanish capital. From Spain Mother Cabrini traveled to Italy. During her stay in Codogno, the new chapel to the Sacred Heart was dedicated and fifty-three sisters made their religious profession. Before she departed for Argentina, she experienced the joy of being received on two occasions by Pope Leo XIII.

" My dearest daughters,

May the balm of he sweetness of the Sacred Heart of Jesus descend in your

souls and render you worthy of the title you bear: Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus." (to be continued)
