PARISH MINISTRIES get connected

LEADERSHIP COUNCILS

- PASTORAL COUNCIL: Helps discern what God's will is for the parish & makes recommendations to the pastor.
- FINANCE COMMITTEE: Assists the pastor in temporal affairs. Members are knowledgeable about financial matters; offer constructive advice about money distribution and use; and prepare the annual parish budget to present to Pastoral Council.
- BUILDING & GROUNDS COMMITTEE: Assists in seeing to the physical maintenance of the church properties. Members are able to advise as to who can make the needed repairs or construction.
- CEMETERY BOARD: Represents and honors all those buried in their respective cemetery; providing administration and local management of the cemeteries.

SERVING THOSE IN NEED

- MISSION CLUB: Promotes awareness of the needs of our sister parish in Haiti, and other missions we support with our tithing program.
- NURSING HOME SERVICES: A group who visits our parishioners who are in the nursing home & assists with Mass at the Gardens.
- LOCAL FOOD PANTRIES: There are baskets in the entrances of every church for donations to food pantries in Mercer & Darke County. We have a group that manages these donations.
- BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY: The group offers to assist the family of parishioners who've passed away with support at the time of the funeral.
- CASSEROLES OF KINDNESS: A group that makes and delivers meals to those in need (illness, accident, new baby, etc.).
- HOMEBOUND MINISTRY-Communion to The Sick: Bring the Holy Eucharist to those who cannot make it to Mass, due to sickness, etc.
- WELCOMING COMMITTEE: This ministry will visit people who have registered as new members of our parish and welcome them.

SMALL GROUPS / DIVE DEEPER

- CANA FAMILY: Small groups for wives and mothers to grow in their understanding of the faith as it pertains to marriage and the family.
- OCIA // INSPIRE: This program is for people who are interested in joining the Catholic Church or would like to learn more about the Catholic faith. Come be inspired by what the Lord has done.
- ST. JOSEPH'S SOCIETY: A Men's Group dedicated to being the spiritual leaders of our families & homes.
- KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS: A Catholic fraternal organization for males 18 years or older. They are involved in the "Measure Up" campaign which aids the handicapped; Halloween, Christmas and Easter programs for the youth of our Parish.
- DOMESTICA APOSTOLATE: Online group to help others in growing and raising families.
- LADIES SODALITIES: There are various Ladies Sodalities open to all Catholic women of the parish. Their purpose is to aid and support the church by way of purchasing items that are needed and also to provide helping hands when needed in the Parish. St. Bernard Ladies Guild, St. Francis Ladies Sodality, St. Henry Altar Rosary Sodality, Daughters of Isabella and St. Wendelin Ladies Sodality are all open to join.

BEAUTIFY OUR CHURCHES

- DECORATING COMMITTEE: Coordinates and manages the decorating of the churches throughout the year.
- GROUNDS UPKEEP & FLOWER BEDS: This committee is responsible for the landscaping.

PARISH MINISTRIES get connected

YOUTH

- RELGIOUS EDUCATION: We offer religion classes during the school day through a release time schedule & evening classes on Wednesday evenings.
- PRESCHOOL RELIGION: We offer two 8-week sessions prior to Easter and Christmas for 4-5 year olds.
- CYO BASKETBALL: This is an opportunity for the high-school-age boys & girls to play basketball in a league comprised of teams from other local parishes
- SMALL GROUPS: For girls & guys in middle school & high school to dive deeper into relationship with our Lord and each other.
- ST. ZITA HANDS: For girls grades 5-12 to find joy in their femininity & vocations and grow deeper in faith
- LITTLE FLOWERS GIRLS CLUB: For girls grades 1-4 to learn about female saints, virtues, and scripture through crafts, games, songs and adoration.
- VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL: Held in the summer on 3 different weeks. Children ages 4 years through 4th grade (previous school year) are invited to attend.

SHARING THE FAITH

- MARRIAGE PREPARATION TEAM: A group of couples who are trained to prepare engaged couples for marriage.
- RELGION TEACHERS (Catechists): Adults who share the faith with our students throughout the week at the CCD center or on Wednesday evenings.
- SMALL GROUP LEADERS: Adults who share their faith in a more casual setting than a classroom with students who willingly attend to go deeper.
- VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL TEAM: Share faith in a simple way with our littles this summer!

PRAYER WARRIORS

- PARISH PRAYER CHAIN: This ministry is comprised of parishioners who have volunteered to pray for specific prayer requests that are received.
- ADORATION AT ST. WENDELIN: Commit to visit Jesus in the Eucharist for 1 hour each week.

LITURGICAL & MUSIC MINISTRIES
