## CCD CENTER NEEDS new sewage lines

Dear Parishioners,

The St. Henry CCD Center sewage lines are in need of immediate repair. These old cast iron lines are disintegrating and can no longer function properly.

Due to small windows of opportunity, some of this work has already begun. Tom's Construction replaced the section of pipe that was accessible from the outside of the building. That section of old cast iron has been abandoned and a new PVC line is currently in place. This portion of repair costs \$14,659.13.

The section of pipe beneath the building itself will be "sleeved" (trenchless sewer line repair) by Huelskamp Drainage who specializes in Cure-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) lining. They will reline the sewage pipe that runs underneath the building. The estimated cost for this portion is \$21,500. This work is scheduled to begin in the next few weeks.

**This project is not fully funded at this time.** The Cluster Maintenance Fund has a balance of \$7,815.02 that will go toward this project. That leaves \$28,344.11 still needed. If we are unable to raise the full amount, the difference will be covered by the parish's General Fund. Should we exceed our goal, any surplus will stay in the Cluster Maintenance Fund for future capital needs.
