Each month, the hope is to take part in assisting one of the parishes within the St. Henry Family with upkeep, followed by fellowship in learning about a devotion within our Catholic faith, and an activity which would lead to raising funds for a need within our churches or community.

The group would meet once a month on the First Saturdays following the 8:00am Mass. The hopes are to finish the meeting at 11:30am. We plan to have our introductory meeting on **Saturday, April 22**, following mass at St. Bernard in the St. Bernard church basement to introduce the group to those interested.

The mission of St. Zita's Hands is to help girls find joy in their femininity within the Church, to grow deeper in their Catholic faith, discover the vocation to which God calls them in His Church, to learn devotions and virtues of the faith, to participate in acts of mercy and charity, and to learn our responsibilities within the Church. We know this is not possible through one encounter, but by planting seeds and watering them through time so they may blossom into great works of God. Through the intercession of St. Zita, we pray this will be possible for all the girls who encounter the group. We will learn to "trust her with the keys" on our journey to a holier life.
