Nathan and Mollie Verdier are the founders of **Morgan's Place Cemetery**, a faith-inspired nonprofit in Sidney, Ohio. Their mission is to walk with families who have experienced the heartbreaking loss of a baby through miscarriage, stillbirth, or shortly after birth.

The Verdier's story begins with their own back-to-back losses. In 2018, they experienced the loss of their daughter **Morgan**, followed soon after by **Marion**, one of their triplets. Rooted in their Catholic faith, Nathan and Mollie felt called to channel their grief into a ministry of hope—making commemoration and burial accessible to families who share in this sorrow.

In response, they dedicated **2.5 acres of their 200-year-old family farm** to establish Morgan's Place Cemetery, located at **1254 State Route 589, Sidney, Ohio.**
