To help your child get ready for first grade, please review reading and math skills this summer. The children should be read to or help you read every day. The following skills should be reviewed this summer a few times each week:

- ❖ Letter sounds
- ❖ Kindergarten sight words
- ❖ Dolch sight words (pre-primer level)
- ❖ 0-100: counting from 0-100, counting forward from any given number within 100, writing numbers randomly between 0 and 100, naming random numbers between 0 and 100
- ❖ Addition and subtraction within 5
- ❖ Coin identification (penny, nickel, dime, and quarter)

We have included some resources for you to help you review and have fun over the summer months including a hundreds chart, flash cards, letter tiles, a reading challenge, and a science scavenger hunt.
