

Sick Day Guidelines

Making the Right Call When Your Child is Sick:

Should I keep my child home or send him/her to school?

School policy (based on CDC recommendations) requires that a child stay home if he or she:

A child should stay home if:

- Has a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher
- Has been vomiting or has diarrhea (within 24 hours)
- Has drainage from an ear or eye (may indicate infection)
- Has a rash (until cleared by a physician)
- Is coughing or sneezing often because this spreads the sickness to others
- Has symptoms that keep him/her from participating in school, such as:
 - Very tired or lack of appetite
 - Cough that he/she cannot control, sneezing often
 - o Headache, body aches, earache
 - Sore throat a little sore is OK, but a bad sore throat could be strep throat, even if there is no fever.
 Other signs of strep throat in children are headache and upset stomach or rash. Call your doctor if your child has these signs. A special test is needed to know if it is strep throat.

24 Hour Rule:

- Fever: Keep your child home until his/her FEVER has been gone without medicine for 24 hours. Colds can be contagious for at least 48 hours. Returning to school too soon may slow recovery and make others sick.
- VOMITING or DIARRHEA: Keep your child home for 24 hours after the LAST time he/she vomited or had diarrhea.
- Antibiotics: Keep your child home until 24 hours after **the FIRST dose** of antibiotics for anything like an ear infections, strep throat, or pneumonia.

We often have many children and adults with colds who come to school, and they pass their sickness to others.

Remember to wash hands and cover coughs and sneezes. Please help others from becoming sick by keeping your child home if he/she is sick.

TO PLACE ORDER: ALL ORDERS MUST BE PLACED ONLINE.

Proceed to fill out your order by completing all fields on the form. You will need to do a new order for each child. Only credit card payments are accepted for online orders. There is no need to print out the receipt. After picture day, package prices will increase and orders must be picked up at Dan's Camera City at no cost or mailed back for an additional fee.

LATE ORDERS: Any orders received after the due date are considered late and will incur an increase in package prices. In addition to the late fee, finished orders will need to be picked up at Dan's retail store, or be subject to shipping charges to have the order shipped directly to you. If you do not place your order by Picture Day, your student will receive their specific ordering code needed to place a late order approximately 3 weeks after Picture Day. Photos are only available to order 90 days after Picture Day. Photos ordered after 90 days, if available, will incur a \$30 late fee.

If your student misses Picture Day, your order will be held and will be fulfilled after Make Up Picture Day.

Coach Liv has taught preschool and elementary chess for 9 years. Coach Liv founded and directed a summer chess camp for children with Down syndrome from 2012-2015. When she began attending Georgetown in 2015, Liv founded The Knight School DC and continued to own and operate that chess academy for 6 years, teaching hundreds of smart chess kids and employing 7 fellow Georgetown students. In 2019, Coach Liv graduated with Honors from Georgetown University; she was grateful to have been able to fully pay for her undergraduate tuition and expenses through chess. Liv taught chess classes at the top preschools and elementary schools in DC, including the National Cathedral School, Aidan Montessori, Key Elementary, and Holy Trinity School. NBC Washington even ran a story on her efforts in increasing female enrollment in DC chess, check it out!

Coach Liv is now working toward her Masters degree in English at Lehigh University, and she decided to bring her chess academy with her to the Lehigh Valley. She will also be teaching chess at Swain School and Moravian Academy. She is excited to partner with Notre Dame and bring fun chess instruction to NDB students!


