



Sick Day Guidelines

Making the Right Call When Your Child is Sick:

Should I keep my child home or send him/her to school?

School policy (based on CDC recommendations) requires that a child **stay home if he or she:**

A child should stay home if:

- Has a fever of 100.0 degrees or higher
- Has been vomiting or has diarrhea (within 24 hours)
- Has drainage from an ear or eye (may indicate infection)
- Has a rash (until cleared by a physician)
- Is coughing or sneezing often because this spreads the sickness to others • Has symptoms that keep him/her from participating in school, such as:
 - Very tired or lack of appetite
 - Cough that he/she cannot control, sneezing often
 - Headache, body aches, earache
 - Sore throat – a little sore is OK, but a bad sore throat could be strep throat, even if there is no fever. Other signs of strep throat in children are headache and upset stomach or rash. Call your doctor if your child has these signs. A special test is needed to know if it is strep throat.
- Other contagious diseases including pertussis, ringworm, impetigo, lice, or conjunctivitis

COVID DIAGNOSIS:

- Students may return to school on Day 6 if symptoms have resolved. (The day symptoms appear is day 0)
- Students must wear a mask for days 6 -10.

24 Hour Rule:

- **Fever:** Keep your child home until his/her **FEVER has been gone without medicine for 24 hours**. Colds can be contagious for at least 48 hours. Returning to school too soon may slow recovery and make others sick.
- **VOMITING or DIARRHEA:** Keep your child home for 24 hours after the **LAST time he/she vomited or had diarrhea**.
- **Antibiotics:** Keep your child home until 24 hours after **the FIRST dose** of antibiotics for anything like an ear infections, strep throat, or pneumonia.

We often have many children and adults with colds who come to school, and they pass their sickness to others. Remember to wash hands and cover coughs and sneezes. Please help others from becoming sick by keeping your child home if he/she is sick.

Happy Halloween Dress Down Day

Listed below are some guidelines for this Dress Down Day.

Listed below are some guidelines for this Dress Down Day:

- Shirts to be worn MUST NOT contain any inappropriate logos, phrases, or images.
- ALL pants must be worn at the waist and should not be baggy. Notre Dame gym pants can also be worn.
- **Bermuda shorts, capris, jeans, or sweatpants are acceptable:**
IMPORTANT - Length of shorts must be no shorter than 1 ½” from knee cap.
- Pajama bottoms, jeggings, or leggings are not allowed to be worn.
- Hats and costume headbands **MAY NOT** be worn.
- **Shoes: Students must wear their Notre Dame regulation gym sneakers or school shoes ONLY.**
- Clothing must be modest, clean and neat looking upon entering the school. No holes, rips, or tears are permitted in any garment.
- All accessories (i.e. hair or jewelry) worn must meet the criteria specified in the Notre Dame Dress Code.

WINTER UNIFORM STARTS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST... UPDATED INFORMATION...



Beginning **Tuesday, November 1st**, all students in grades K-8 will be required to wear the regulation Winter School Uniform.

As a reminder, school shoes must be black, brown, or blue, and **sneakers may not be worn with the regulation Winter School Uniform. All girls in grades K-8 must wear knee high socks or tights with the winter uniform.**

PLEASE NOTE: If your child is cold during the school day, he or she should wear the navy long-sleeve banded bottom shirt, the navy ¼ zip performance fleece pullover, or the navy v-neck pullover sweater. **The navy hooded or navy crew neck Notre Dame gym sweatshirt may only be worn with the gym uniform.**

Keep in mind that we do go outside during the winter months. We check with the local weather service frequently to monitor the current temperature and wind chill, and we also walk outside to check the weather before sending students outside. During the winter months, please be sure to dress your child appropriately for outside recess (gloves, hats, scarves, etc.) and keep this in mind when getting ready for school.

Our uniform still stands as a symbol of pride and discipline for our school. Each student who wears it represents the high standard that exists because of your support and cooperation.

- Please remember that as the weather starts to get chilly to please send your student in with a coat, as we will continue to take the students outside as much as possible.

SAFETY RULES

1. Walk — don't run — from house to house using sidewalks when possible
2. Be aware of and avoid open flames like candles in jack-o'-lanterns
3. Avoid homemade treats and only eat factory-wrapped candy
4. Remove makeup soon after trick-or-treating to avoid skin irritation
5. Children under 12 should have an adult along to supervise.
6. If a child is old enough to trick-or-treat without an adult, he or she should still go with a group of friends and they should stick to familiar houses and neighborhoods.
7. If you have a group of older children heading out alone, consider turning on a mobile tracker app so parents can follow their progress from home.
8. If kids are going out on their own, set up a timeline expectation. For instance, have the kids check in at specific times throughout the night and set a curfew.
9. Reflective tape should be used as much as possible on costumes, candy bags, strollers and wagons.
10. In addition to adding reflective elements to costumes, check that they're easy to walk in and don't restrict breathing or vision.

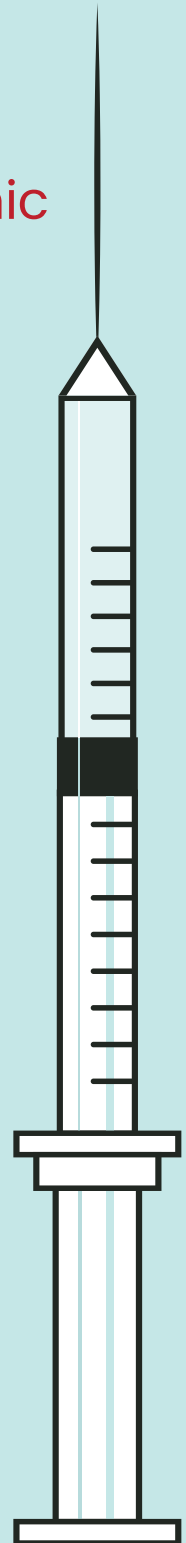
