- -The joint meeting with committee members will be held at the Oct. 17 PC meeting at St. Joe's. The PC officers will meet with Fr. Jim to plan the agenda.
- -In light of the recent flood it is imperative that our Tri-parish has a disaster plan that should be coordinated with the city and the Mayor's office. A consensus motion was made to ask the Tri-parish Human Concerns Committees to take on the task of development of the plan, the liaison, Jacki Scholze will take it to the committees.
- -Starting in 2018 any continuing PC members will be on tiered terms (1, 2, and 3 years). Current members who are interested in in continuing on the council should be prepared to announce their intention and term choice at the September meeting so we can begin to prepare for recruitment of new members. Representation will continue to be equal representation, that is, 3 from each parish.
