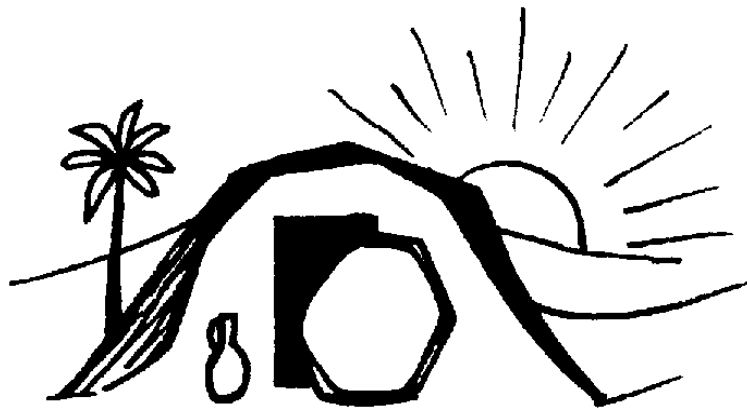
## The Apostles Creed:

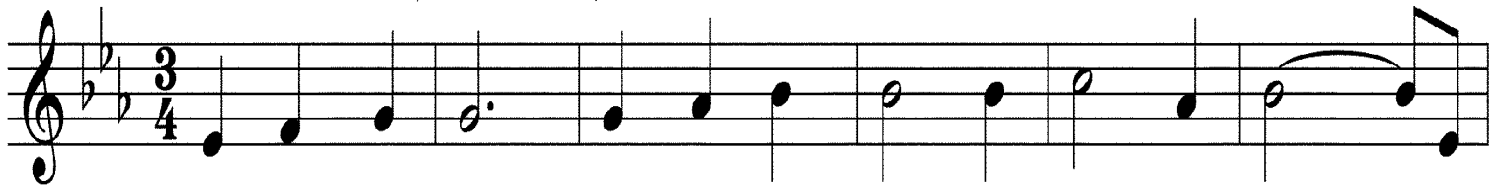
