

A Note from your DRE...

In this 6th Sunday of Easter from the Gospel of John 14:15, Jesus says, "if you love me, you will keep my commandments". Those commandments help keep us grounded in our faith. It's been years since we learned those commandments—some more than others. Can you remember all of them? Can you remember them in the correct order? Did you know that the commandments are given to us twice in sacred scripture for different reasons? Do you know where to find them?

Now that the K-8th grade religious education program has ended for the school year, I'm aoina to write a note about a commandment each week, and include some information from the catechism about how they are still applicable to our lives.

So, let's start with the list.

- (1) I am the LORD your God, You shall not have other gods beside me.
- (2) You shall not invoke the name of the LORD, your God, in vain.
- (3) Remember the Sabbath day—keep it holy.
- (4) Honor your father and your mother.
- (5) You shall not kill.
- (6) You shall not commit adultery.
- (7) You shall not steal.
- (8) You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- (9) You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- (10) You shall not covet your neighbor's house or belongings (goods).

Did you get them in the correct order? The two locations in the Bible are from Exodus Chapter 20 and Deuteronomy Chapter 5, with the former placing 'neighbor's house' before 'neighbor's wife'. I pray your week be filled with joy.

Forming Good Stewards

John 14:15-21

"Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me."

Jesus knew that after he ascended to heaven many would attempt to complicate his existence, mission and message. He was aware that from the time of Moses people tried to avoid or deny the nature of God and his simple command to love God and to love other as we love ourselves. He knew that if we can be convinced that love of God and others is complicated, we would get discouraged and give up. He anticipated that some would claim to have superior and exclusive knowledge of how to love God in order to gain control over the mind and lives of others. Jesus assured us that loving God by understanding and observing his commandments, and loving others, is not complicated, but it can be difficult. It requires that we do right, not just look right; do good, not just feel good. It means we must eliminate evil in our lives and challenge the evil in our world, our community, our work place, our home. That can be inconvenient, unpleasant and risky. And that takes love.

Intercultural competencies workshop in June

On June 6-8, 2017, the Diocese of Owensboro will host a workshop titled "Building Intercultural Competence for Ministers," held at Mount St. Joseph Conference and Retreat Center in Maple Mount. Participants will learn how to better frame issues of diversity in terms of the Church's identity and mission to evangelize; seek an understanding of culture and how it works; develop intercultural communication skills in pastoral settings; expand one's knowledge of the obstacles which impede effective intercultural relations; and foster ecclesial integration rather than assimilation in church settings, with a spirituality of reconciliation and mission. The workshop cost is \$30 and includes all materials and meals. Lodging is also available at the retreat center for \$30/night. Learn more at owensborodiocese.org/bicmworkshop/.

Sophia Awards 2017

Nominations for Sophia Awards 2017 are being accepted through July 15, 2017. Individuals 18 or older may nominate someone. The person from each parish receiving the highest number of nominations will receive the award. Eligibility for nomination: Anyone 65 or older (married couple, individual, member of a religious community or an ordained deacon or priest) who embraces and lives a life of stewardship-giving of their time, talent and treasure.
