



A note from your DRE...

From the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 25 this week, Jesus gives us the parable of the three servants who receive different amounts of talents while the master is away. The most common forms of money were shekels and talents, with the later denarius coin being Roman. The shekel weighed on average 11 grams, or .02 pounds, a talent was around 75 pounds, and could consist of different materials (gold, silver, etc.). In the parable, the man praises and chastises the different servants with the phrases "well done, my good and faithful servant" and "you wicked, lazy servant." I think that sometimes, we may think of God in only those terms of chastisement. Have you heard someone negatively declare they "have to go to church this week"? That can give us an image of God with a clipboard, striking bad people off the list. Jesus reminds us this week that he came for the salvation of everyone. I pray this week that we focus on our positive relationship of God, and that we strive to hear his words, "well done."

We continue this week in Religious Education, and are beginning the Sacramental Preparation programs for our 2nd & 8th graders this month. In RCIA, we will discuss the Marian dogmas and Advent preparation. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs, please let me know.
