

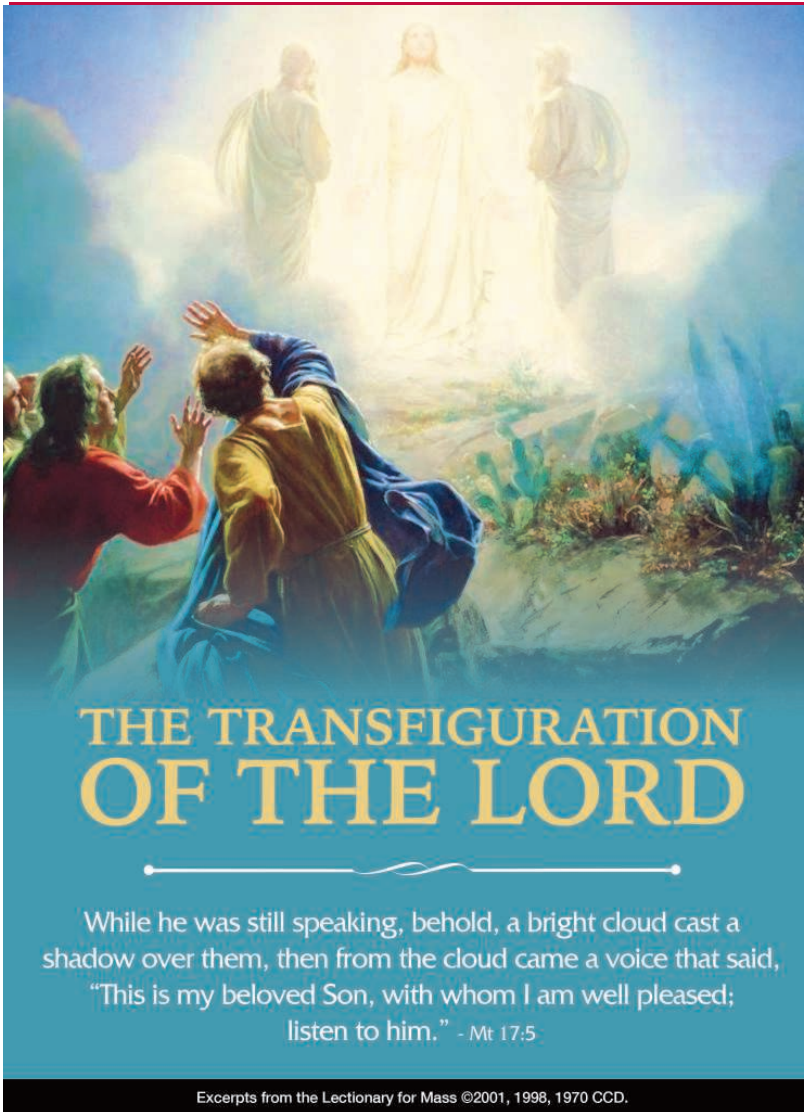

A note from your DRE...

On this Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 17, Jesus goes up a high mountain, and is transfigured before the disciples. They hear God's voice saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased, listen to him." Sometimes, it seems like we need a bright light and a loud voice to reveal to us what we already know. Jesus revealed his glory then to the apostles, and does so today again at Mass. As we continue to develop our relationship to Jesus through prayer and the sacraments, we ultimately grow closer to the Father. I pray this week that our lives continue to be transformed by knowing Jesus.

Returning to our summer discussion of the Ten Commandments, the tenth commandment is "You shall not desire your neighbor's house or field, his male or female slave, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor." Most of our neighbors don't have donkeys, but they do have lots of stuff that may be desirable. This gets into the mortal sins of avarice and envy, putting the desire for money and property before our obligations to others. From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (2536), "it forbids avarice arising from a passion for riches and their attendant power". Also, "it refers to the sadness at the sight of another's goods and the immoderate desire to acquire them for oneself, even unjustly" (2539). From Matthew 6:21, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." I hope this has been an interesting discussion of the Ten Commandments this summer. And, thank you for your attention last week as I discussed our upcoming K-8 Religious Education and RCIA programs.
