

the homes of our homebound parishioners by the priest and/or by lay ministers to parishioners who are unable to attend Mass.



A note from your DRE...

From the Gospel of Mark Chapter 1 this week, we hear John the Baptist "proclaiming a baptism of repentance" as we prepare for the Messiah. He also goes on to say "one mightier than I is coming after me". Like the people in that time, we may focus on that latter statement. When hearing someone "mighty" was coming to save them, the people expected another King David, someone who would kill the occupiers of their lands and re-unite the kinadom. When we consider someone who is mighty or powerful, who do we think of? What image of Jesus do we hold in our minds and in our hearts? On this 2nd week of Advent, I pray that our preparation includes the repentance of our sins, and that we let Jesus redeem us.

I went to a diocese meeting last week. We considered a presentation from Robert Feduccia on "Why are Youth and Young Adults Leaving the Church?" From his study, 63% are deciding to leave the Catholic Church between the ages of 10 and 17, with the most frequent being age 13. I had no idea it was that young!!! So, I also pray this week that we encourage our youth to develop a personal relationship with Jesus, and that we also show them by our actions, what it means to be a follower of Jesus.
