



unable to attend Mass.



A note from your DRE...

On this 4th Sunday of Advent, we hear a familiar reading from the Gospel of Luke Chapter 1, where the angel Gabriel greets Mary with "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you." I've written about that greeting before in the original Greek. Do you remember the word? 'Kecharitomene.' - Mary was conceived without sin, having already received the most absolute amount of complete, perfect, and enduring grace. One thing that always strikes me from this Gospel reading is that when other people see an angel, they drop to their knees in fear. Mary doesn't. The gospel tells us that Mary was "greatly troubled," but not because she didn't know how babies were conceived. Rather, Mary had already decided that her life would be one of perpetual virginity in consecration to God. Then, both Mary and Joseph planned to be married and decided that they would not engage in a relationship where she could conceive a child. Finally, in the time span of that conversation with Gabriel, Mary went from deciding not to have children to being the Mother of God. I am happy that Mary said "yes" to God's plan for her life.

This 4th week of Advent goes by quick. Be sure to attend Mass on Christmas Eve (Sunday 4 or 8 PM) or Christmas Day (Midnight or 9 AM). Depending on the Mass you attend, you will hear the genealogy of Jesus from the Gospel of Matthew, angels appearing to the shepherds in the Gospel of Luke, or the Incarnation from the Gospel of John. If you only heard one Gospel on Christmas, then give yourself a Christmas present and read the other Gospels. When we read the Gospels, we can hear Jesus talkina to us.

Religious Education and RCIA are not in session this week to prepare for the birth of Jesus. I pray that you have a very Merry Christmas.

Forming Good Stewards

Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word."

On the Second Sunday of Advent we noted that "John [The Baptist] was just being John." He discerned God's will for him and he did it. Now we hear of "Mary just being Mary," a young teenager in a tiny hamlet on a craggy hilltop in the northern region of Galilee. Mary heard a message from God so amazing she wondered how it could happen. But she realized it was God's will for her and she consented. There were many details and consequences she could not know, but she said "Yes!" to be the human mother of God incarnate. That was "Mary just being Mary." That is all God asked of her and that is all God ask of us - to be all that God creates us to be. For us, just as for John and Mary, we begin by identifying, accepting and developing all of the unique talents, abilities and gifts God has given to each of us, and then using them to the best of our ability for ourselves and for others. Is that not the greatest gift we can give to Jesus when we celebrate his birth on Christmas? Is our present for Jesus ready?
