A note from your DRE...

On this 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 13, we hear parables of the Kingdom of heaven. We hear again about the end times, collecting everyone and separating out individuals. Heaven is such an amazingly wonderful place, filled of pure love that our minds just cannot grasp it. Jesus tries to give us an analogy through a parable to help us understand. Still, there is no comparison. What is your analogy of Heaven? Streets paved with gold? Floating on a cloud playing a harp? Grass tennis courts? Jesus tells us, "The Kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field." What's your treasure? The Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace, and joy. Fill your heart with treasures from God.

Returning to our summer discussion of the Ten Commandments, the ninth commandment is "You shall not covet your neighbor's wife." Before anyone thinks there is a loophole, this also applies to coveting your neighbor's husband or unmarried person not living next door of either gender. If you view any form of media, you might hear the question, what's wrong with a little lust? Jesus said in Matthew Chapter 5:28 "Everyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her." We addressed that commandment a few bulletins ago.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (2515) uses the word "concupiscence" to "refer to any intense form of human desire." "It unsettles moral faculties and, without being in itself an offense, inclines man to commit sins." Sadly, this is one of the results of Original sin. The Catechism goes on to address the purity of heart (2517) as "those who have attuned their intellects and wills to the demands of God's holiness" in "charity, chastity, love of truth, and orthodoxy of faith." From CCC 2521, "purity requires modesty, an integral part of temperance," and CCC 2522, "modesty protects the mystery of persons and their love. It encourages patient and moderation in living relationships."

Thankfully, God is merciful and is there to forgive us when we ask. Remember, confession is available every Saturday from 12:30 to 2:00 PM. I pray this week that the effects of concupiscence may be as minimal as possible.

K-8 Religious Education Program

We have made some changes to the program this year. To allow families to spend more time together, we are moving the class time to 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. This allows for the families to attend the Mass that is most convenient, maintains the ease of parking/ transportation flow, and if the children attend the 10:00 AM Mass, do not have to stay past noon for their religious education. We will still have donuts and juice for them prior to class. As there are a small number of students in some grades, we are combining classrooms to K-1, 2-3, 4-6, & 7-8. I have invited our incoming 8th graders for the Sacrament Confirmation to provide help in the classrooms as a project for service hours. Not only will this help with the children in the program, but will allow others considering a teaching vocation some practical experience. We have adopted a new curriculum that matches the Gospel reading from that particular Sunday, and has a handout that goes home with the child each week. They will work in an age appropriate catechism book each week, and that book will go home with the children at the end of the year. Please contact the office if you have any questions or concerns.

Volunteer to be a Catechists/ Teachers for K-8 Religious Education

Please prayerfully consider if this ministry may be calling you. I realize this is a significant time commitment. Please review the calendar posted to the website. Due to holidays or events at the Church, there are some weeks without classes. By having multiple catechists & helpers in the room, there would be the opportunity if someone needed to miss for a family event. If you are unsure of how or what you would teach in the classroom, there is a specific lesson plan for each week's class. The children will be working in a catechism book that is written for their age level. Please contact the office to volunteer or for more information.
