

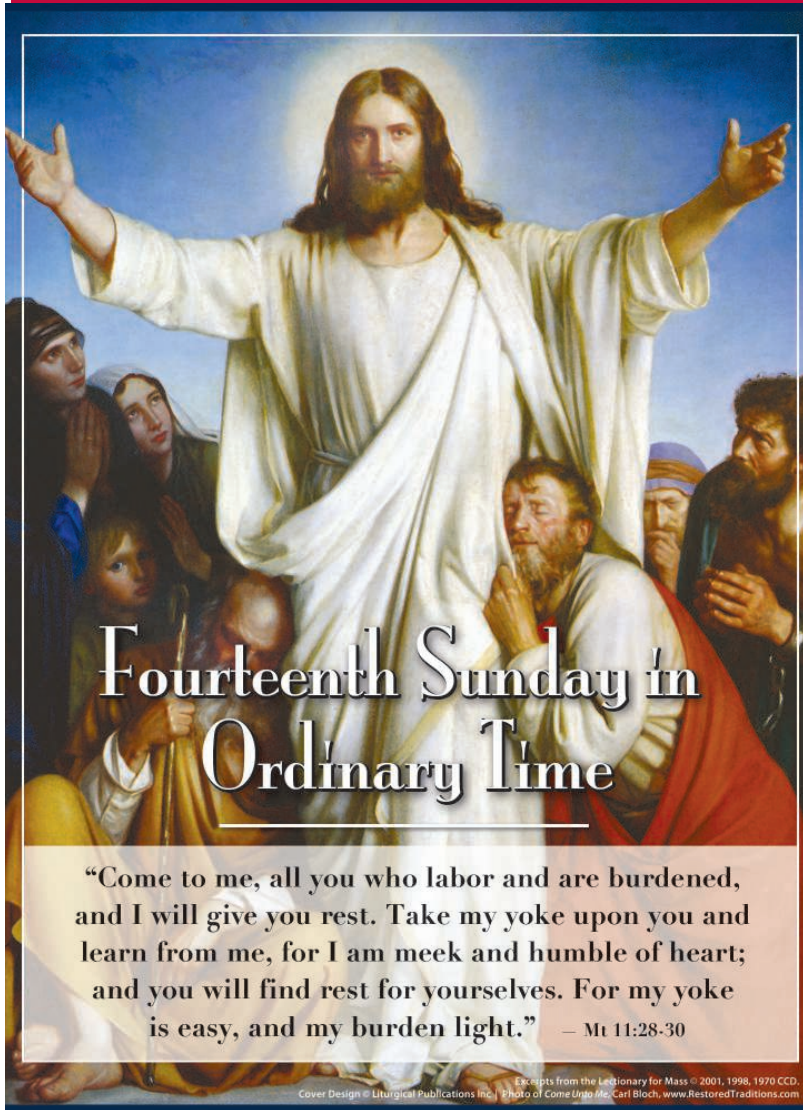

A note from your DRE...

On this 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 11, Jesus says, "No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son". We know that Jesus died on the cross for our sins. We also remember the different miracles that Jesus performed in feeding multitudes of people and healing those who were sick. Sometimes, we may forget that Jesus revealed himself on earth so that we may have a relationship with him, and in doing so, a relationship with the Father. God, the Father, is true love and has a monopoly on happiness. Sure, we have things that make us happy for a while, but God's love for us will never end. As we spend more time and grow closer in our relationship with Jesus, we grow closer in our relationship to God. Yoke yourself to Christ. Your eternity depends on it.

Returning to our summer discussion of the Ten Commandments, the sixth commandment is "You shall not commit adultery". Perhaps this week's discussion is the most difficult, confusing, or extra challenging in lieu of the language used in a publication. From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (2334), "God gives man and woman an equal personal dignity", "since both were created in the image and likeness of the personal God". From the beginning, God's plan was for male and female to be together in marriage, as it "concerns affectivity, the capacity to love and to procreate, and in a more general way the aptitude for forming bonds of communion with others." (CCC 2332). Thus, outside of the marriage of a man and woman, everyone is called to chastity. From CCC 2341, "the virtue of chastity comes under the cardinal virtue of temperance, which seeks to permeate the passions and appetites of the senses with reason". From CCC 2348, all the baptized are called to chastity, to "put on Christ", the model of all chastity. "All Christ's faithful are called to lead a chaste life in keeping with their particular states of life."

God is merciful, and is there to forgive us when we ask. Remember, confession is available every Saturday from 12:30 to 2:00 PM. I pray this week that we continue to grow in our relationship with Jesus, and overcome the many temptations of the flesh.

Forming Good Stewards

Matthew 28:16-20

“Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations . . .”
 After his resurrection Jesus revealed himself to his disciples who had been his most faithful followers to prepare them for the day when he would return to his Father and no longer be physically with them. Jesus knew it would take time for them to fully realize the meaning of all they had seen and heard; they would be uncertain and fearful about how to proceed with out him to lead and teach them; they would have to choose whether or not to accept the task of carrying on his mission and teaching others his message by their words and actions. After they saw Jesus ascend to his Father they banded together in anxiety and uncertainty. We may be tempted to judge them harshly for their lack of faith and courage. But what would we have done? They believed in Jesus but they had witnessed many unusual and frightening things. They stayed together and resolved their doubts and conquered their fears. When we have doubts and fears do we stay together? Do we spend time in prayer to resolve our doubts and act with courage?
