A note from your DRE...

On this 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 10, Jesus says, "Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed". Our focus this week is that we should not be afraid as God knows us intimately and will never deny us. We read in the Bible where we are often told to not be fearful, with a parsing of that phrase. What is it that we fear the most? I think it has to do with suffering. It could be suffering from a fear of losing a job, suffering in the death of a family member, suffering in the loss of a relationship, suffering from an addiction, suffering from abuse, suffering from being rejected or ridiculed by others, and many other types of suffering. When we encounter fear or suffering, I pray we trust in God and know that bad things will pass.

Returning to our summer discussion of the Ten Commandments, the fourth commandment is "Honor your father and your mother". Returning to the context for the commandments, the Israelites were slaves for 400 years, and as such, they were bought and sold based on their usefulness or functionality. What happens to a slave as they age and can no longer work? In context to a societal structure, we find this instruction in Leviticus 23: 22, "When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not be so thorough that you reap the field to its very edge, nor shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest. These things you shall leave for the poor". From the Catechism of the Catholic Church, we read about the family as a part of God's plan (2201), the family and society (2207), the duties of children (2214), and the duties of parents (2221). The Catechism also gives instruction on the role of the family and the Kingdom (2232), the duties of civil authorities (2234), the duties of citizens (2238), and the political community and the Church (2244).

We had a final count of 28 children who attended Vacation Bible School. It looked like the children had fun learning about being God's steward for the earth. All of the pictures are on our website and some are on Facebook. I would like to say thank you to all the adult and teen volunteers who helped last week, your church staff, and Fr. Mike and Fr. Emmanuel for spending time with the children. Many of the children and their families were able to end the week by attending noon Mass on Friday.

Forming Good Stewards

Matthew 28:16-20

"Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations . . ."
After his resurrection Jesus revealed himself to his disciples who had been his most faithful followers to prepare them for the day when he would return to his Father and no longer be physically with them. Jesus knew it would take time for them to fully realize the meaning of all they had seen and heard; they would be uncertain and fearful about how to proceed with out him to lead and teach them; they would have to choose whether or not to accept the task of carrying on his mission and teaching others his message by their words and actions. After they saw Jesus ascend to his Father they banded together in anxiety and uncertainty. We may be tempted to judge them harshly for their lack of faith and courage. But what would we have done? They believed in Jesus but they had witnessed many unusual and frightening things. They stayed together and resolved their doubts and conquered their fears. When we have doubts and fears do we stay together? Do we spend time in prayer to resolve our doubts and act with courage?
