

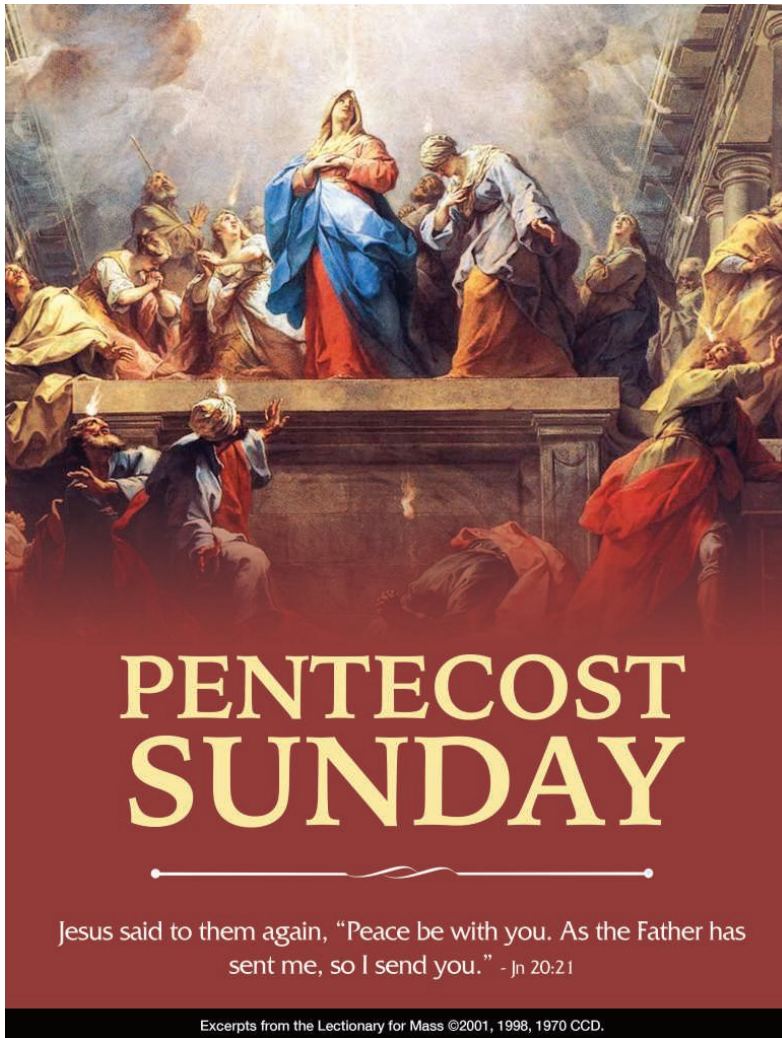

## A Note from your DRE...

Depending on Mass you went to this weekend, you would have heard a different Gospel reading about Pentecost. From the Gospel of John, Chapter 20, Jesus "breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit'". Here Jesus is speaking to the disciples as they receive the Holy Spirit. A focus for us this week is never lose hope. As human beings, we have been on the earth for quite some time. We have to go all the way back to the book of Genesis to find God breathing life into Adam. Jesus gives us hope again then and today, as we are centered in the Holy Spirit, and go forth to proclaim his message of unity with the Father.

Returning to our discussion of the Ten Commandments, the first one is "I am the LORD your God, you shall not have other gods beside me." Exodus Chapter 20 goes on to say, "You shall not make for yourself an idol...you shall not bow down before them or serve them". I'm sure all of us think how silly it is to worship a golden calf. But, how many people worship a car, house, a sports team, or something else? Who do we serve in our lives today? Do we worship God at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation or do we find somewhere or someone else to serve? We may also refer to this as the mortal sin of Pride – putting myself before God.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (2086 & 2095), the first commandment embraces faith, hope, and charity, and these theological virtues give life to our moral virtues. When we worship our God, we give him our full adoration, prayer, and sacrifice.

### Forming Good Stewards

Matthew 28:16-20

**"Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations . . ."**  
After his resurrection Jesus revealed himself to his disciples who had been his most faithful followers to prepare them for the day when he would return to his Father and no longer be physically with them. Jesus knew it would take time for them to fully realize the meaning of all they had seen and heard; they would be uncertain and fearful about how to proceed with out him to lead and teach them; they would have to choose whether or not to accept the task of carrying on his mission and teaching others his message by their words and actions. After they saw Jesus ascend to his Father they banded together in anxiety and uncertainty. We may be tempted to judge them harshly for their lack of faith and courage. But what would we have done?
