

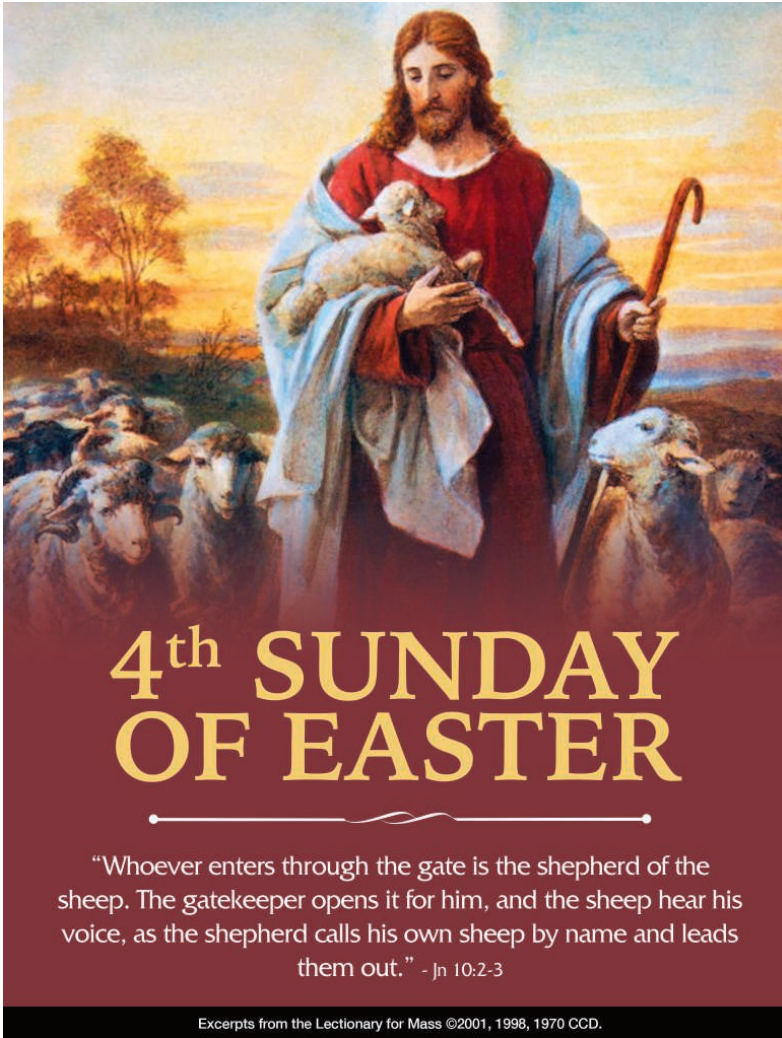

A Note from your DRE...

In this 4th Sunday of Easter from the Gospel of John, Chapter 10, Jesus uses the parable of the Good Shepherd, a gate, and sheep following his voice. Jesus tells us, "Whoever enters through me will be saved". One of the ways to hear Jesus's voice and develop that relationship with him is to spend time in prayer and reading Scripture.

This is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, and last Thursday (May 4) was the National Day of Prayer. Part 4 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church is all about Christian Prayer. If you have been struggling with distraction or dryness in your prayer life, this is a wonderful section to read. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has a free digital read online at www.usccb.org. Select "What we Believe" to find it.

In my daily prayer, I try to remember the acronym **FAITH**. I pray for the **F**orgiveness of my sins, a prayer of **A**doration, prayers of **I**ntercessions, prayer of **T**hanksgiving, and then **H**ear the Word of God by reading scripture and saying the Lord's Prayer.

Last week at Religious Education, we missed the 2nd Graders and their siblings as we celebrated the Sacrament of their 1st Holy Communion at 2:00 PM Mass. The Knights of Columbus joined us in their regalia at the Mass. Check out the website for pictures.

I pray that you be filled with joy, and that your prayer life be fruitful as you continue towards holiness.

Forming Good Stewards

John 10:1-10

"The shepherd walks ahead of his sheep, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice."

Our image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd romanticizes the role and status of the shepherd.. However, Jesus was well aware that the life of a shepherd was very difficult and they were considered to be on the low level of society. Then, as today, they were called bedouins, which means "nomads." They moved from place to place to find food and water for their flock and the flock is totally dependent on the shepherd for protection from predators and thieves. The shepherd depended on the flock for milk, meat, and wool. Such mutual dependence establishes a strong bond between shepherd and flock. Like the good shepherd and great leaders of history, Jesus lead from the front, with wisdom and courage. Jesus used the image of shepherd and sheep to teach the people of his day, and us, that he will always lead us to what is right and good, and we can follow him in confidence and have faith in him.

Intercultural competencies workshop in June

On June 6-8, 2017, the Diocese of Owensboro will host a workshop titled "Building Intercultural Competence for Ministers," held at Mount St. Joseph Conference and Retreat Center in Maple Mount. Participants will learn how to better frame issues of diversity in terms of the Church's identity and mission to evangelize; seek an understanding of culture and how it works; develop intercultural communication skills in pastoral settings; expand one's knowledge of the obstacles which impede effective intercultural relations; and foster ecclesial integration rather than assimilation in church settings, with a spirituality of reconciliation and mission.
