

#### A note from your DRE...

From the Gospel of Mark Chapter 1 this week, a leper approaches Jesus and says, "if you wish, you can make me clean." What was the normal treatment for skin infections at that time? Leviticus Chapter 13 gives us a step-by-step procedure, ultimately resulting in the person having to live outside of the town, identify themselves as "unclean" around others, and the rabbi would determine if they were healed and could return to the town. Jesus touches him and says, "I do will it. Be made clean." And after being healed, that was why Jesus told him to follow what "Moses prescribed." This might be a prayer request we try this week. We may decide to use a different word of phrase than 'clean'. It could be a request for forgiveness, healing, intention, or inner peace. God answers all prayers, just not necessarily in the manner and time we want. This week, may we pray "Jesus, if you wish, you can make me \_\_\_\_."

Lent is upon us, starting on Ash Wednesday this week. It is not a holy day of obligation, but recommended that we attend Mass to prepare for the penitential season of Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is obligatory from age 14 onwards. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

- 1. If you have an existing FACTS username and password, select "Sign In". If you are a new FACTS user please select "Create username and password" to begin.
- 2. Then click on **Start Application**.
- 3. Select the appropriate school year.
- 4. Complete the steps as prompted. Mar. 5-18 – Registration Opens (current and new families – submit online) (\$50 reg. fee applies to tuition) – Please note: all registration fees are per family.

Mar. 19 – Apr. 1 – Registration (\$50 reg. fee from current families does not apply to tuition) Apr. 2 – Registration (reg. fee increases to \$75 for current families and does not apply to tuition) June 1 – Deadline to create FACTS account July 13 – Deadline to receive tuition discount for payment in full (3%)

KN registration (please note) -

Last year Kentucky Law changed the age cutoff date for students entering Kindergarten. The provision states: A child who becomes five (5) by August 1 may enter Kindergarten in accordance with KRS 158.031. Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year OCS will follow this new law for all incoming Kindergarten students. ALL Kindergarten students <u>must be 5 years old by August 1</u> in order to register and enroll.
