

Deacon Brett's Discourse

I help to provide weekly Catholic ministry at Green River Correctional Complex in Central City. Since last December there are more fences and gates, and less movement outside of cell dorms. Coming to the Chapel – even when not really appreciating or respecting a service – has become a way to get extra yard time. That, and the departure of regular members of our Catholic community by parole or transfer has made creating and experiencing worship more challenging.

I remind myself that bringing Catholic ministry to prisoners is simply about presence. The Church doesn't do outreach ministry so the Church will be appreciated, respected, or affirmed as the height of Christianity. The Church serves so that Christ is present to the prisoners, the hungry, thirsty, needy, lonely, outcasts, the ill and the dying.

Emerging on the GRCC yard from the Security Building is like finding Narnia through the wardrobe. Keeping the proper attitude for ministry there – or anywhere it's needed – is more like staying on the good side of Alice's looking glass. It's not about who we or the Church are getting, it is really about who we are giving. Too often we're seeing that backwards.

Applications are being accepted for the next Spiritual Direction Training Program, which will begin the week of Oct. 15 at Mount Saint Joseph Conference and Retreat Center. The two-year program consists of four weekly training sessions each year. This program prepares participants for the ministry of spiritual direction from a Catholic perspective and in the spirit of the Ursuline founder, Saint Angela Merici. During each of the eight weeks, participants enter into study, reflection and prayer around a topic fundamental to the understanding and practice of spiritual direction. Participants receive intense training by a coordinating team of religious sisters and educators. Attendance is required to receive certification as a spiritual director.
