

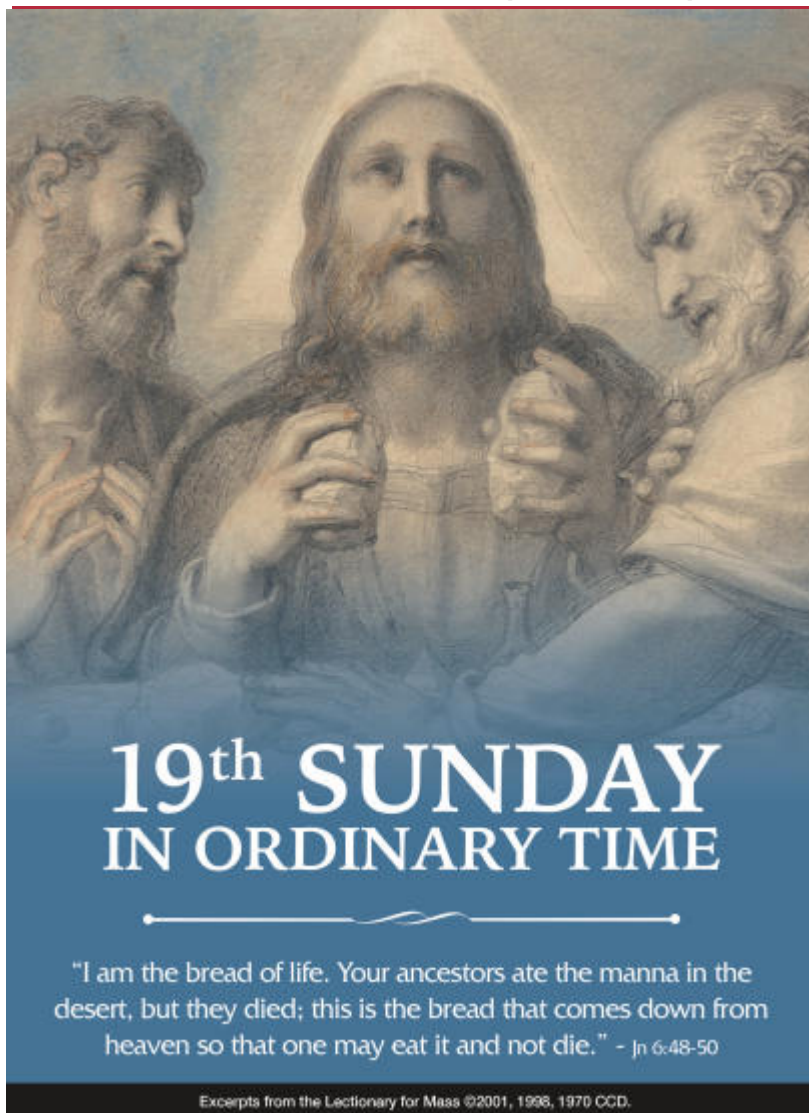

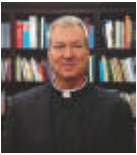

A note from your DRE...

In this week's reading from the Gospel of John Chapter 6, we hear a continuation of the Bread of Life discourse. Jesus says, "I am the bread of life" and compares Himself to the manna that God provided to Moses and the Israelites in the desert when they left Egypt for the Promised Land. Part of the education for all Jewish boys and some girls would be to read and/or memorize the first five books of the Old Testament. When Jesus compares Himself to the manna, they know exactly what he is talking about, which is why they question his human origin. Still, this is after he has changed water into wine, healed a sick child almost dead, healed others who could not walk, and fed the large crowd by multiplying the loaves of bread and fish. I think that we may sometimes do the same things. Jesus has given us many blessings and an example of how to live our lives; yet, we still question those teachings and plans for our future. I pray this week that we continue to experience that conversion of heart from the bread of life.

Wednesday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. The Mass schedule is 6:30 AM, 9 AM (school mass), and 12:00 PM. There will also be a vigil Mass on Tuesday, August 14 at 6 PM. This is the oldest feast day of Mary, with its origins around 100 AD. At the Council of Chalcedon in 451, Emperor Marcian requested the relics of Mary be brought to Constantinople. Now referred to as Saint Juvenal, Bishop of Jerusalem responded that there were no relics as "Mary had died in the presence of the apostles; but her tomb, when opened later . . . was found empty and so the apostles concluded that the body was taken up into heaven."

2018-2020 Spiritual Direction Training Program - Register by Aug. 31

Applications are being accepted for the next Spiritual Direction Training Program, which will begin the week of Oct. 15 at Mount Saint Joseph Conference and Retreat Center. The two-year program consists of four weekly training sessions each year. This program prepares participants for the ministry of spiritual direction from a Catholic perspective and in the spirit of the Ursuline founder, Saint Angela Merici. During each of the eight weeks, participants enter into study, reflection and prayer around a topic fundamental to the understanding and practice of spiritual direction. Participants receive intense training by a coordinating team of religious sisters and educators. Attendance is required to receive certification as a spiritual director.
