

A note from your DRE...

From the Gospel of John Chapter 6 this week, we hear that the crowd could not find Jesus, and "they themselves got into boats and came to Capernaum looking for [him]." While John Chapter 6 is usually about the Bread of Life discourse, this Scripture passage challenged me. Have I become complacent with my Faith? According to Google, my house is 1.7 miles away from the Church which is a 5 minute car ride or a 33 minute walk. The Sea of Galilee is about 13 miles long, 8 miles wide, and the boat ride would have taken 2 hours to cross the water. That would be by sailing or paddling with oars as opposed to a motorboat. I went kayaking on the ocean this summer, and was exhausted after the hour time limit. So, not only is distance the challenge, but I know Jesus is here at the Church during weekday Mass or exposed during Eucharistic Adoration. These "crowds" weren't really sure where Jesus went, but they went on an exhausting journey to search for Him. I pray this week that our actions reflect our effort in seeking Jesus.

After summer break, it is good to be back posting again. Thank you to Deacon Brett Mills for posting a weekly commentary in my absence. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs, please let me know.

2018-2020 Spiritual Direction Training Program -Register by Aug. 31

Applications are being accepted for the next Spiritual Direction Training Program, which will begin the week of Oct. 15 at Mount Saint Joseph Conference and Retreat Center. The two-year program consists of four weekly training sessions each year. This program prepares participants for the ministry of spiritual direction from a Catholic perspective and in the spirit of the Ursuline founder, Saint Angela Merici. During each of the eight weeks, participants enter into study, reflection and prayer around a topic fundamental to the understanding and practice of spiritual direction. Participants receive intense training by a coordinating team of religious sisters and educators. Attendance is required to receive certification as a spiritual director.
