

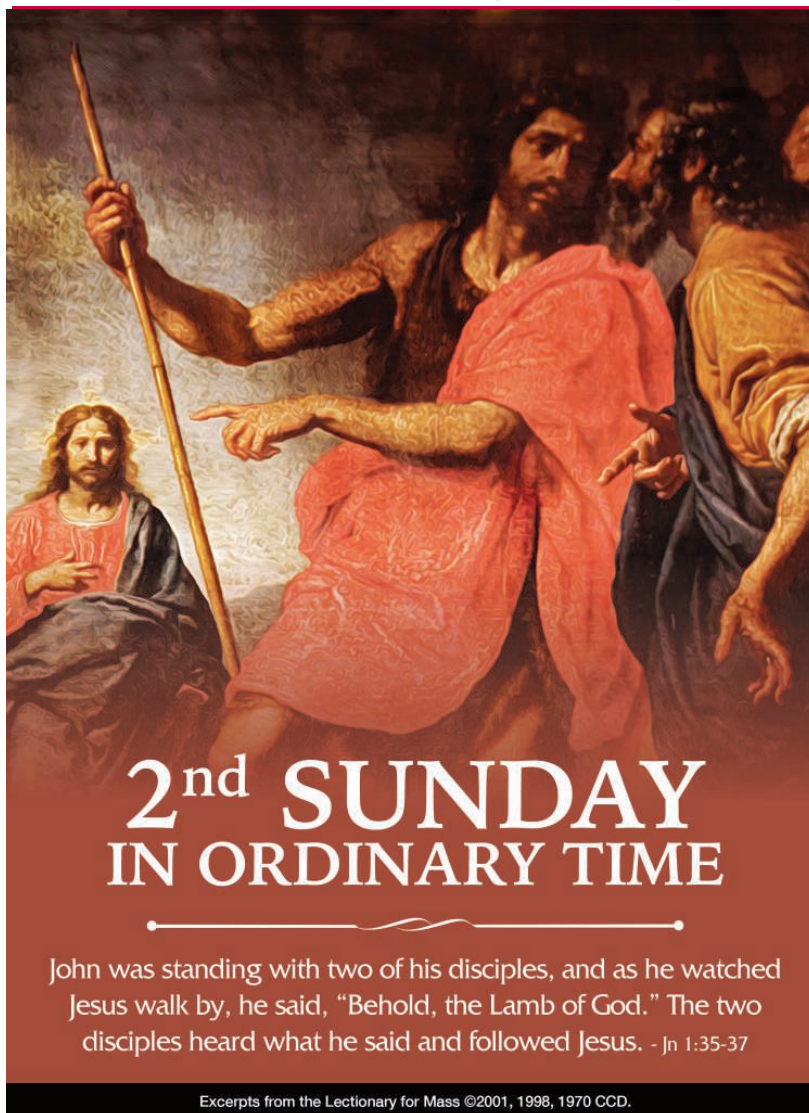

A note from your DRE...

On this 2nd Sunday in Ordinary time from the Gospel of John Chapter 1, we hear Jesus gathering his disciples. We hear Jesus say, "'You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas' – which is translated Peter." Why does Jesus change his name? First, Jesus as the Son of God has the authority to change names. God also changes other names in the Bible, for example, Abram to Abraham; Jacob to Israel; and Saul to Paul. Whenever God changes someone's name, he does so after he changes them and calls them to do his will. When we are baptized and confirmed, we are given a Christian name and God then calls us by name. I pray this week that we acknowledge God's call and answer him.

Religious Education and RCIA are not in session this week. It has been a series of starts and stops with the holidays. We will have some more consecutive weeks into the next month. There are so many programs occurring right now. Check them out in the bulletin or website.
