

Deacon Brett's Discourse

Temper can refer to an inclination for anger, but that's really a modern short-form for what it means to lose one's temper. In much older use temper refers to balance between qualities, especially extremes. In that sense having a temper and being in temper describe a good disposition.

I am the last in my family to practice a Christmas tradition of making homemade boiled custard (so enjoyably unhealthy that I protect people by consuming most of it myself). Cooking that custard required me to learn the technique of tempering eaas. The basic idea is to aradually raise the temperature of an egg yolk mixture with a little hot milk so it can join a lot of hot milk without scrambling.

Reflecting on that careful influence upon eggs led me to the surely unoriginal spiritual practice that I call "tempering." The basic idea is to subtly introduce my religious sensibilities and spiritual awareness in daily secular situations. Hopefully, I'm raising the temperature of those situations so that the people I'm influencing can more easily live themselves into the larger mix of the religious spirituality calling us all to Christian holiness. Let "Temper, temper..." become one evangelizing motto.
