

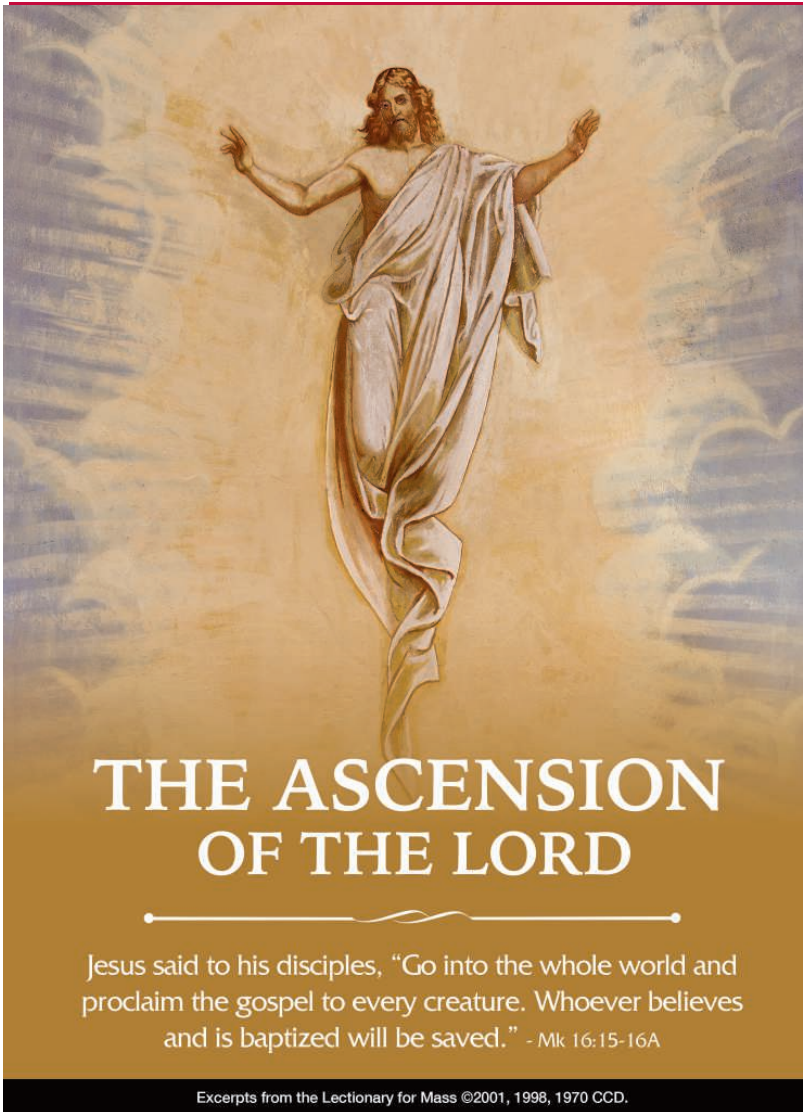

A note from your DRE...

There is a lot going on this week/ weekend with the Ascension of our Lord, Mother's Day, and BBQ Festival. Some of remember that the Ascension used to be on Thursday. What happened? "In accord with the provisions of canon 1246, §2 of the Code of Canon Law, which states: "... the conference of bishops can abolish certain holy days of obligation or transfer them to a Sunday with prior approval of the Apostolic See," the National Conference of Catholic Bishops of the United States decrees that the Ecclesiastical Provinces of the United States may transfer the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the Seventh Sunday of Easter according to the following procedure." (USCCB.org)

Last year, we talked about the title used to address our mother, Mary, Queen of the Universe. In Luke's Gospel, written in Greek, the angel Gabriel addresses Mary with "*Chaire, Kecharitomene.*" We may recognize the Latin phrase, "*gratia plena.*" Or, even more familiar, "*Hail, Full of Grace.*" This year, how about another title used to address mothers, or more specifically, women, and that is the Hebrew word 'ezer. You may read the English translation in Genesis 2:18 as "helper" and think this is a subservient or somehow demeaning phrase. However, of the 26 times this word "helper" is used in the Old Testament, 17 times it used to describe God. That sounds like a great way to describe the women in our lives. So, my prayers and Happy Mother's Day wishes to all mothers, god- mothers, grandmothers, stepmothers, foster mothers, and those who serve as mothers.

RCIA is in session this week and then we join the Parish next weekend for fellowship with the New Member's Welcome Brunch. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs, please let me know.
