



A note from your DRE...

There are different readings this week for Pentecost Sunday, or the Vigil if you attended Mass on Saturday. When I think of Pentecost, I always go to Chapter 2 of the Acts of the Apostles. The Apostles had abandoned their lives, careers, and families and followed Jesus for three years, waiting for Him to expel the Romans and restore the glory to Israel. Instead, they witness him being tortured to death. What did they do? They ran away, or worse, denied him. Then, they witness Jesus' Resurrection and his Ascension, and yet, they are still hiding in that upper room, terrified that they are next. At Pentecost, the Apostles receive the Holy Spirit, speak in tongues, and the people there "hear" the Apostles' words in their own native language. What we sometimes don't remember is that after Peter delivers this tremendous, verbal testimony, "those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day" (Acts 2:41). What is the significance? Christianity was considered an illegal superstition, punishable by asset forfeiture and death. 3,000 people signed up to lose all their possessions, including their life. That must have been some speech! We know it was the Holy Spirit. I pray this week we have this same experience, allowing the Holy Spirit to lead us to truth and forgiveness.

This is the last week of our RCIA Program as we join with the Parish for fellowship with the New Members Brunch. Welcome to all those who have joined us here at Blessed Mother Church. Our Faith Formation programs have ended for the fiscal year, and we will start back up with Vacation Bible School in July. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs, please let me know.

Safe Environment

The safety of our children is the responsibility of every Christian. The Diocese of Owensboro sexual abuse policy is available at this parish in the back of church, or in the parish office and also on the diocesan web site (<https://owensborodiocese.org/safe>).

Life Line Screening, a leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will offer their affordable, non-invasive and painless health screenings at **Blessed Mother Catholic Church on 7/19/2018**. Five screenings will be offered that scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries which is a leading cause of stroke; abdominal aortic aneurysms which can lead to a ruptured aorta; hardening of the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease; atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat which is closely tied to stroke risk; and a bone density screening, for men and women, used to assess the risk of osteoporosis. Register for a Wellness Package which includes 4 vascular tests and osteoporosis screening from \$149 (\$139 with our member discount).
