A note from your DRE...

In this week's reading from the Gospel of Mark Chapter 12, Jesus says, "Beware the scribes, ... They devour the houses of widows and, as a pretext recite lengthy prayers. They will receive a very severe condemnation." On the surface, we may ask why visiting a widow and saying long prayers would be worth of condemnation. In the time of Jesus, this is a patriarchal culture and a woman's income will depend on her father, husband, son, or other male relative. If there is no male relative, then how will she earn income? Or, is she permitted or physically able to harvest food or another labor task? There is no Social Security system. So, she depends upon the generosity on her fellow Hebrew citizens (Exodus 22:21 & Deuteronomy 10:18). Jesus goes on to observe a poor widow placing two small coins into the temple treasury and teaches us that "this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood." Who gets to use those two small coins in the temple treasury? Yes, it is those same Scribes or Pharisees who "devour" the house of the widow. By convincing her to donate all her money to the treasury, then they can spend it on the ministry needs they determine. To bring this into modern times, this should evoke the same feeling as when someone swindles money from an older adult. I pray this week that serve God through our time, talent, and treasure.

Today is National Stewardship Sunday. Over the next few months, we will be discussing stewardship – using our gifts of time, talent, and treasure for the glory of God. Our Parish programs and Advent preparation will be about "gifts" – what we give and receive from God. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs, please let me know.

Forming Good Stewards

Good Stewards Are Formed, Not Forced!

"Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury."

Jesus seems to be critical of rich people. But Jesus was friends with Joseph of Arimathea who buried Jesus in his tomb, and Zacchaeus the tax collector, a man hated by others for his wealth but who gave half of his wealth to the poor. Jesus did not confront people because they had wealth. He challenged those who took advantage of others to gain their wealth and those who did not properly share their wealth with others; who use their possessions to distinguish and separate themselves from others; who think their wealth makes them better than others. Jesus uses the example of the poor widow who gave all she had to contrast with those who gave large sums from their surplus that they had acquired by taking advantage of widows. He is also challenging us to pray and reflect on our "wealth," the "things that we own," or more accurately, the "things that own us." What thing or activity are we so attached to that we cannot share with others. What "owns" us?
