

A note from your DRE...

From the Gospel of Mark Chapter 10 this week, Jesus is asked what someone must do to inherit eternal life. Jesus says to follow the Commandments and then "sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." So, does that apply to us? In the Old Testament, having wealth was considered a sign of God's blessing. This same concept is still presented today as the "prosperity gospel" in some other ecclesial communities. That "prosperity gospel" goes two ways - if you are wealthy, then God favors you; or if you give more money to the Church, then God will give you more wealth. That was the challenge presented to Jesus in the Gospel; how can someone "earn" entrance into Heaven. Jesus' response to sell everything is to remove the distractions in life that are making one self-dependent instead of relying on God. It is only by God's grace that we can make it to Heaven. I pray this week that we continue to develop that relationship with God and experience abundant life now and eternally.

Religious Education and RCIA have an extended leave with school Fall break and Priest Appreciation Sunday/ Block Party. Before the break, the RCIA candidates and catechumens considered the topics of Covenant history; Trinity; Tradition, Scripture, and Magisterium; and the Kingdom of God.
