

The Deacon's Discourse

In rules #5 through #8, St. Ignatius of Loyola generally addresses spiritual desolation and how to respond to it:

Rule 5: In spiritual desolation never make a change from spiritual decisions or habits adopted before the spiritual desolation began.

Rule 6: Actively resist spiritual desolation by making prayers of petition to God, meditating on the genuine and ongoing presence of God, examining and addressing the immediate cause of the desolation, and doing penance in direct opposition to desolate impulses.

Rule 7: Consider spiritual desolation from God's perspective. God does not cause it, but allows spiritual desolation as a trial. God remains present and never takes away sufficient grace to accept Salvation. Since God remains, the opportunity in spiritual desolation is to grow better at resisting spiritual desolation by resisting it.

Rule 8: Patiently bear the loss of spiritual consolation and patiently practice resisting the spiritual desolation to ease the return of spiritual consolations. A normal spiritual life is a life-long alternation of spiritual consolation and spiritual desolation of various durations.

The essential concepts in these four rules are: the never of #5; resist (#6); consider (#7); and normal (#8). No one's too low to work through desolation.

The Ministry of Praise invites the sick, elderly and homebound to offer their prayers and sufferings for the needs of their parish. We would like to offer this ministry here at Blessed Mother Church. 
