A note from your DRE...

On this Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph in the Gospel of Matthew, we again hear the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in dreams. In order to protect Jesus, Joseph first leads the Holy Family to Egypt, then returns to Judea, and then onto Nazareth in the region of Galilee. Both Joseph and Mary trace their genealogies through King David and back to Judah. The Gospel reminds us this week of the role of God in our families.
