A note from your DRE...

On this 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time from the Gospel of Luke Chapter 16, Jesus gives us the parable of the dishonest steward. It was the responsibility of the steward in that time to manage all the property of his boss. The boss demands some accountability from the dishonest steward. Hopefully, we see the comparisons to our own life. Everything we have is a gift from God, and as such, we are to manage those gifts and be accountable to God. Thus, all of our time, talent, and treasure belong to God, and we just manage them. Are you a good steward of those gifts? What happens if we aren't? Back to that parable, the boss/ landowner/ master also had the right to punish the steward for mismanagement of the property. The crowd listening to Jesus may have been expecting to hear that the dishonest steward was beaten, incarcerated, or received justice. However, that isn't the message. The master treats the dishonest steward with mercy, as God treats us with mercy. Let us pray this day that we are good stewards of our time, talent, and treasure.
