A note from your DRE...

On this Feast of the Presentation of the Lord from the Gospel of Luke, Jesus is consecrated to God in the temple in Jerusalem. Dating back to 1200 BC, Moses imparted this practice on all the Hebrews, along with a sacrifice of a turtledove or piaeon. As Catholics, we still practice this tradition in part when we bring our children to be baptized. Thankfully, we don't have to bring birds to the Church, but we still offer sacrifices to God. From the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1268, "By Baptism they share in the priesthood of Christ, in his prophetic and royal mission." Do we sacrifice ourselves to God? As we review our Parish stewardship information, have we considered this as a way to sacrifice our time, talent, and treasures to God for the needs of our Parish? Like our parents, Mary and Joseph consecrated Jesus to God. From the Catechism, consecrated is "the dedication of a thing or person to divine service by a prayer or blessing." Do we consider our Parish stewardship as an example of divine service? Let us pray this day that we remember our mission at baptism in serving others as priest, prophet, and king.
