A note from your DRE...

On this Feast of the Baptism of the Lord from the Gospel of Matthew, we hear that Jesus is baptized by John in the Jordan. Now, this baptism was unlike any of ours as Jesus is already God and has no need to repent. While John initially protests, Jesus requests to be baptized to show the relationship between God and humanity. Following his baptism, "the Spirit of God descended like a dove" and "a voice came from the heavens." If we were present when this happened, what would we do? I guess someone would take out their cell phone and start taking pictures or record it. I think I would want to go and tell as many people what I just witnessed. That must have been an amazing sign!!! There are just so many signs from God – individual, Sacramental, Biblical, and the documented 152 Eucharistic Miracles in 20 countries around the world. From the Baltimore Catechism, a Sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ that confers grace. Every time we receive the Sacraments, not only do we witness a sign from God, but we experience an encounter through the Holy Spirit. Let us pray this day that our actions reveal the wonderful signs God has done for us.
