A note from your DRE...

On this 2nd Sunday in Ordinary time from the Gospel of John, we again hear about the baptism of Jesus through the testimony of John the Baptist. John says, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." Hopefully, we recognize that phrase as one the Priest makes during the Communion Rite during the Liturgy of the Eucharist at Mass. Our response is, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed." Hopefully, we recognize our response is similar to the centurion from Matthew 8:8. In one of our Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) program discussions on the liturgy, we search the Bible for those phrases heard and said during Mass. There are over 40 instances during Mass when Catholics recite or respond to 125 Scripture references, not including the first or second reading, responsorial psalm, or Gospel. Who says Catholics don't read the Bible. Let's just hope we read it more than once a week. Are you ready to give testimony like John the Baptist or the centurion, as a disciple of Jesus? Let us pray this day that our words and actions offer testimony to the presence of Jesus in our hearts. Religious Education and RCIA are not in session for the Holiday weekend. Youth Group is in session today. If you made a New Year's resolution to spend more time with God, then I invite you to our Bible Study on Wednesday from 6 to 7 PM. If you have questions about any of our Religious Education programs or faith formation needs.

For our Religious Education Program, we are in need of an assistant catechist in our K-1 classroom as well as our 4-6 classroom. We meet Sundays from 8:30 to 9:30 AM and follow the DCPS calendar. Lesson plans and educational materials are provided. All catechists are required to be Safe Environment certified, which the Parish will provide at no charge. Forming Good Stewards

But what is the sin of the world? John observed a self-centeredness in the people of his day that is the opposite of being centered on God. John understood that such self-centeredness is at the heart of all sin in the world and recognized Jesus as the Lamb of God, the person who would sacrifice himself to help us root out self-centeredness and become centered on God. Jesus did that with his life and his teaching. But he needs our help. Because God has given us the great gift of free will we must choose to stop being centered on ourselves and choose to put God at the center of our lives. When we are centered on God we become a person for others. If everyone in the world becomes a person for others would there be any sin of the world?
