



A note from your DRE...

On this 14th Sunday of Ordinary Time from the Gospel of Matthew 11:28, Jesus says, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." When we hear this passage, we may think of physical "labor" and the body being tired. Yes, Jesus can heal us and give us some rest. Throughout history, the Catholic Church instituted Holy Days of Obligation not only to help us focus on God, but to give people a time to rest. Unfortunately, many see a "Day of Obligation" as a scheduling burden. Yet, before all of the workplace safety laws, this was a way for a person to rest from their physical labor. Continuing from the Gospel from last Sunday on suffering, Jesus wants to give rest to the "burdened." For some, the burden they carry is physical or emotional pain. Depending on the situation, some people find themselves lost in hopelessness. Even though Jesus says "take up his cross and follow after me", Jesus will "give you rest." Let us pray this day we unite our suffering to Jesus and accept his invitation for healing.

We celebrate our country's independence this day this weekend. One of the freedoms we may have taken for granted before this pandemic was our freedom to attend Mass. As such, here is an excerpt of a prayer from the USCCB in 2012 on religious liberty:

"Grant, we pray, O heavenly Father, a clear and united voice to all your sons and daughters gathered in your Church in this decisive hour in the history of our nation, so that, with every trial withstood and every danger overcome— for the sake of our children, our grandchildren, and all who come after us—this great land will always be "one nation, under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all." We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen"

Forming Good Stewards

July 5, 2020 Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Mt 11:25-30

"Take my yoke upon you and learn from me . . . For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

Jesus spoke those words to his disciples before he was cruelly betrayed, forcefully arrested, falsely accused, unjustly condemned, viciously beaten and brutally crucified. After that occurred his disciples would have justifiably wondered: "Is the yoke of Jesus easy and his burden light?" If the mission of Jesus had ended with his death that would have been a reasonable auestion. But Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to his disciples. They recalled that he also said, "For I am meek and humble of heart and you will find rest in me." Aware that all we have, all we are, and all we will be comes from our loving God, such humility of heart and the knowledge that we will rest in the Risen Lord makes his yoke easy and his burden light. After his Resurrection Jesus' disciples understood what he meant. His yoke was to choose to do the will of his Father. His burden was to fulfill the mission of his human nature, regardless of the cost. Do we understand? Are we willing to accept his yoke and burden?
