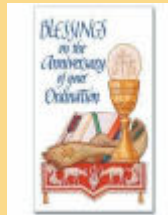

A note from your DRE...

On this 7th Sunday of Easter, we celebrate the feast of the Ascension of the Lord. In the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles Chapter 1, as the apostles "were looking on, Jesus was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight." What was their experience? The disciples were terrified at witnessing Jesus arrested, tortured, and crucified. Then, Jesus is Resurrected and eats with them. Now, 40 days later, Jesus is gone again. What about that range of emotions in a little over a month's time? Perhaps that is like our range of emotions over these past days of the pandemic. Fear? Hope? Uncertainty? Let us pray this day we trust in Jesus.

The Ascension occurs 40 days after the Resurrection, which would have been last Thursday. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has permitted the transfer of the Holy Day of Obligation from the Thursday to the following Sunday. As a response to COVID19, Bishop Medley has "chosen to extend the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday celebrations of the Eucharist." This has certainly been a challenging time, and if you are confused, please let us know so that we can help. As we re-opened last Wednesday, we are trying to keep up and take all of the required precautions. We have a link on our website to take you to a video message from Bishop Medley, along with additional information.

Monday is Memorial Day. From the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, Memorial Day is to remember and honor all military personnel who died in the service of our country, particularly those who died or were mortally wounded in battle. From the USCCB, a prayer for Memorial day.

God of power and mercy,
you destroy war and put down earthly pride.
Banish violence from our midst and wipe away our tears, that we may all deserve to be called your sons and daughters.

Keep in your mercy those men and women who have died in the cause of freedom and bring them safely into your kingdom of justice and peace. We ask this though Jesus Christ our Lord. R/. Amen

John 17:1-11

"And now I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world while I am coming to you."
Jesus prays to his Father during the "Last Supper Discourse" in St. John's Gospel. He takes this last opportunity with his disciples to prepare them for the impending fate that awaits him for teaching about God's love and how we can truly love God. Gathered in an upper room to celebrate the Passover Jesus speaks to his Father, but he is communicating to his disciples that the time is near when he will no longer be physically with them, but he will be with them in the Spirit the Father will send so that they will understand all that he did and said, and have the courage to imitate him and bring his message to others by their words and actions. At the Last Supper the disciples did not fully understand all that Jesus was trying to tell them. But after his death and Resurrection the Spirit was upon them and they began to live as he taught them. Do we understand Jesus did and said and do we have the courage to imitate him?

Rest in Peace

In these dark days, we invite all Catholics of Western Kentucky to engage in a project meant to communicate faith and hope to our neighbors and be a sign of encouragement and support to all who are suffering.



Beginning at 8:00 PM on April 11, Holy Saturday, and through May 31, Pentecost Sunday, use the symbol of light as an outward sign in some way on your property as a witness to all of the prayers burning in our hearts and as a reminder that the light has come into our world and has conquered even death.

Bring out the Christmas lights you have stored away. Wrap a strand around a door or window, visible to all who pass. Place a flower wreath on a door and weave through it a strand of light. Two stands of lights can be used to form a cross on a garage door. Strings of light can be woven through bushes, or even a small tree. The candles you put in your windows at Christmas can be placed there once again. Be creative!

Each night, as you "turn on the lights", you might also light a candle and say a prayer to the one "who sheds his peaceful light on all humanity" (the *Exsultet* from the Easter Vigil) for an end to the pandemic. Let's unite with one another in prayer this Easter season and remind one another and our neighbors that we are never beyond the reach of God. Let's light up the world!
