Recap for Rosary Ministry for the month of Nov/Dec.

The metal rosary fundraiser was a huge success on Dec. 3 and 4. Donations amounted to \$2,327 (minus some credit card transaction charges). A special thank you to MaryAnn Stacey for her part in making and funding her rosaries. They brought in \$1,000. The other \$1,300 came from the mirror and bracelet rosaries made by Chris. In the month of November/December we gave away 627 mission rosaries:
