Each officer serves for a 2 year term — June 2024 through May 2026

Regent:

Prepares agenda & presides at all meetings

Ensures Financial Reviews are completed on time every 6 months

Interacts with District Deputy/State Representative and State Officers

Appoints & trains Committee Chairmen

Serves as ex-officio member of all committees, except Nominating Committee.

Countersigns all Local Court checks written and signed by Treasurer

Signs all correspondence of the Local Court

Has final authority to terminate membership

Performs other duties as the laws of THE ORDER require.

Vice Regent:

Assists Regent when requested

Performs other duties as designated by the Regent

Recording Secretary:

Keeps accurate proceedings of all meetings

Reads all bills at the meeting

Conducts correspondence of the Local Court, except as specified under duties of Financial Secretary

Performs other duties as designated by the Regent.

Financial Secretary:

Receives all monies for the court & issue receipts.

Posts receipts in cash book

Transmits and counts money with Treasurer.

Keeps an account of all dues paid and list of members. Reconciles Court Membership Records with National CDA Records

Orders supplies

Treasurer:

Receives all monies from Financial Secretary

Pays all bills with approval of Court

Countersigns checks with Regent

Presents Treasurer's Report each month

Makes bank deposits immediately.

Balances check book monthly.
