PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



As I mentioned at each of my Masses last weekend, I am so happy to come to St. John Vianney as your new pastor and priest. I look forward to my tenure here with you and God willing, here until my own retirement, which could be some eight years away. And if you're really nice to me, no one says I have to retire at 70! :-) (just saying!!) **We welcome Bishop Zinkula to our 8:30am Mass as my official installation will take place.**

Your staff and community could not have been more welcoming this past weekend and I thank you all for that. It seems like I've met way too many of the coolest people and anxious to get to know you. As far as names are concerned, I felt like it was drinking from a fire hose: completely overwhelmed meeting so many at one time, but patience is indeed a virtue. As I mentioned in one of those Masses, give me four years and hopefully I'll be picking up on many of your names. I know it is really special to be recognized and called by your own name and I promise to do my best.

A little history of my own background: I am the 8th of 13 children, sharing the priesthood with two of my brothers. My father (Elmer) died two years ago on Corpus Christi Sunday and my mother (Helen) lives in Fairfield. Our family grew up on a very traditional farm just north of Richland, raising mostly hogs but had cattle, horses, sheep, chickens, cats, dogs, ducks, and through high school, I had some 50+ rabbits!! Corn, soybeans, alfalfa ... far from most farms today with fewer and more specialized practices. I love the outdoors and getting back to the farm whenever I can as my brother, Andy, works hard to keep it going!

I graduated from St. Ambrose University, and after a couple years in education, I accepted a position at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll, Iowa, as a music director/liturgist. It was from there that I decided to go to the seminary and it felt right to stay in the Sioux City diocese where Bishop Lawrence Soens ordained me in 1988. After ten years in northwest Iowa, I decided to return to the Davenport diocese to be closer to family. I came back in 2001, spent 10 years at St. Mary's in Riverside, Holy Trinity in Richmond, and St. Joseph's in Wellman. My next ten years were just across town at Sacred Heart Cathedral and now my present assignment. That's my exciting life in a nutshell!!



My favorite pastime is my sheltie, Joey! I'm sure you'll all have the opportunity to meet Joey someday. He's still just a little more than a year old and very much a puppy with a lot of energy. Joey loves people but becomes overwhelmed with crowds so we'll move slowly in introducing him to the community. Shelties are sheep dogs known for their herding tendencies. As your shepherd here at St. John Vianney, I feel very fortunate that my best friend is around to help in the herding of this very special flock of people!! We both look forward in tending our sheep!!




